In accordance with this aim, we are committed to sustainable development and recognise that much of our indirect impacts lie in our supply chain; an impact we are determined to minimise.

Our Sustainable Procurement Policy defines our commitment to sustainable development in our procurement activities and to responsible purchasing.

Project Group will:

- Consider suppliers on the basis of their environmental policies and performance as one of the factors when awarding supply and service contracts.
- Ensure that, where other factors are equal, supply and service contracts are awarded to suppliers on the basis of their environmental policies and performance.
- Draw this policy to the specific attention of key suppliers and communicate it as widely as is practicable to the potential supply market.
- Work with our suppliers towards mutually established, sustainable goals and standards. Aiming to improve sustainability and reduce the environmental impacts of products and services, work towards developing sustainable products where possible and to improve overall performance.
- Consider sustainable alternatives, such as recycled and refurbished products in relation to conventional ones. Specifying environmentally friendly alternatives to conventional suppliers wherever practicable.
- Promote awareness of sustainable procurement and communicate this policy to Project Group staff involved in procurement activities.

This policy will be regularly reviewed every year and reported to all Directors.
