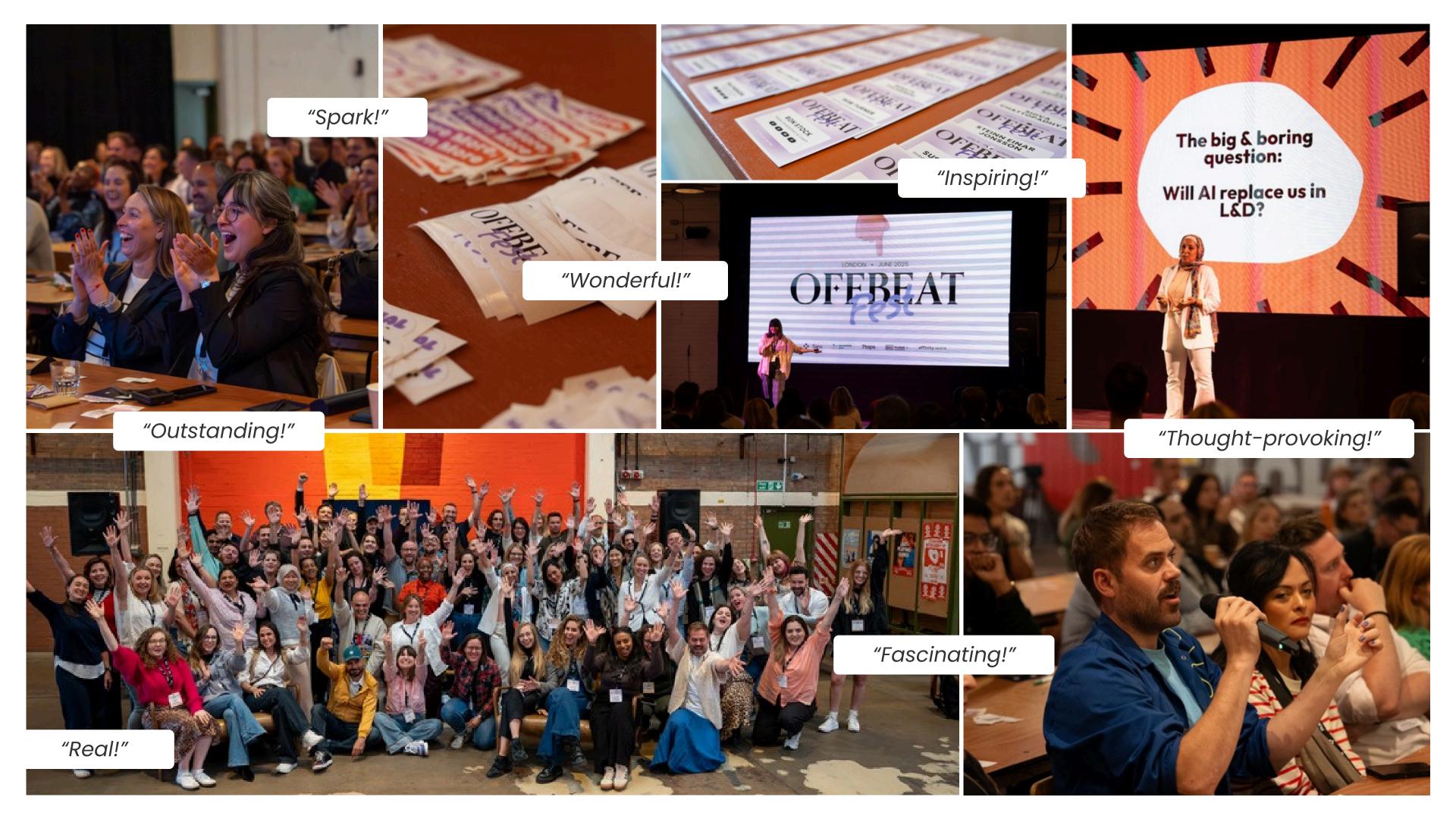

Creating long-lasting, business-oriented learning experiences. Designing programs that stick, and actually move the needle for the business.

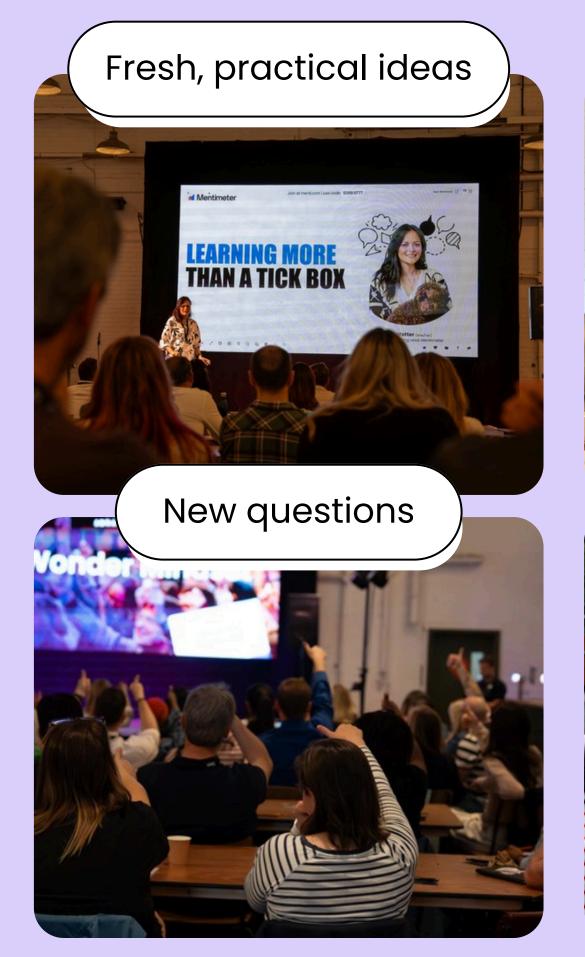
Developing strategies to support self-directed learning. Encouraging people to take charge of their growth, without leaving them to figure it out alone.
