[Traffic & Safety – eglintonTOday Update](#)

The City of Toronto is installing a segment of the eglintonTOday Complete Street on Eglinton Avenue West from Avenue Road to Chaplin Crescent. Moving into 2025, the Complete Street installation will continue to connect existing cycling infrastructure between Bicknell Avenue and Mount Pleasant Road.

Council approved the Beltline Gap Connections Project in June 2024.

This project proposes new cycling and pedestrian infrastructure over the Allen Road Expressway to close the gap between the York Beltline and Kay Gardner Trails.

The project area includes sections along Marlee Avenue, Roselawn Avenue and Elm Ridge Drive, and the Allen Greenway multi-use trail.
