FINDINGS OF FACTS AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. This Court has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter.
2. This matter came before the Court pursuant to Chapter 4.01 of the Muckleshoot Tribal Code.
3. Petitioner is the Tribal Prosecutor, acting in his or her official capacity at the direction of Tribal Council Chair or Vice-Chair to obtain an Order for Exclusion on behalf of the Muckleshoot Indian Tribe.

1 4. Notice of Hearing: Respondent was served via publication, publication posted 1/7/2026. The Tribe
2 moved to serve by Publication pursuant to 3A.02.040(c) with a showing that diligent attempts of
3 personal service have been made. Respondent appeared. Respondent agreed to the Exclusion.
4 Respondent contested the Exclusion. Respondent did not appear after having been provided
proper notice of proceedings; This order entered in default.

5 ORDER

6 It is hereby Ordered that:

7 Respondent is **EXCLUDED** from entering or remaining on the Muckleshoot Indian Reservation.
8 For the purposes of this order, territory of the Muckleshoot Indian Tribe means all lands and
9 buildings within the exterior boundaries of the Muckleshoot Indian Reservation. Nothing in this order
shall restrict the ability of Respondent, if entitled to do so, to lawfully use licenses, easements, grants,
or rights-of-way of record within the territory of the Muckleshoot Indian Tribe. A map has been
provided to Respondent with this Order. A map will be provided to the Respondent upon request.
Please call the Court at the phone number on page one to request a copy of the map.

10 Respondent may come onto the Muckleshoot Indian Reservation for the purpose of attending
11 Tribal Court proceedings to which he is a party but must be escorted by law enforcement to and from
12 the courthouse. Respondent shall call the Court three (3) business days before the hearing at (253)
13 876-3203 to confirm attendance and arrange for Law Enforcement escort. Law Enforcement officers
14 will meet respondent at 9 a.m. on the morning of the hearing in front of the Starbucks on the corner
of M Street and Auburn Way in Auburn, WA. (1436 Auburn Way S, Auburn, WA 98002) Any
and all future hearings involving this Respondent will be conducted by telephone or Zoom.
Respondent shall call court at 253-876-3203 for link or call-in information. Respondent may
not enter upon the Reservation to attend court hearings.

15 Other/Exceptions: _____

16 The terms of this order are effective immediately and shall remain in effect until the _____ day of
17 _____ 20____ at 5:00 p.m. unless modified at a later hearing. This matter shall
18 come before the Court for a continued hearing on the tribe's petition to determine if a permanent
order of exclusion should be entered on the _____ day of _____ 20____ at 9:30
19 a.m. The order may be dismissed, modified, extended, or made permanent at the next hearing.

20 The terms of this order are effective immediately and shall not expire. This order shall be effective
until revoked or modified by the Court.

21 There is good cause to CONTINUE the hearing on the Tribe's Petition for Respondent to be
22 served. There is good cause to serve notice of the PERMANENT ORDER by publication, pursuant
to 3A.02.040(c) of the Muckleshoot Tribal Code.

23 Any person subjected to any order of the Court under Chapter 4 may appeal to the Muckleshoot
Court of Justice of Appeals.

24 WACIC Data Entry

25 It is further ordered that the clerk of the court shall forward a copy of this order on or before the next
26 judicial day to Muckleshoot Police Department and shall enter it in a computer-based criminal
intelligence system available in this state used by law enforcement to list outstanding warrants.
