17 **YOU AND EACH OF YOU** will please take note that a PETITION
18 FOR GUARDIANSHIP has been filed in the Muckleshoot Tribal Court
19 and a hearing has been scheduled for **TUESDAY the 12th OF MAY,**
20 **2026 AT 1:30 PM** in the Muckleshoot Tribal Court of Justice
located at 39015 172nd Avenue SE, Auburn, WA 98092.

21 The purpose of this hearing is to hear testimony to
22 establish a legal basis for the petition and to present evidence
23 as to what is in the best interest of the youth regarding the
petitioner's request for guardianship.

24 Muckleshoot Child and Family Services is required to submit
25 a Guardianship Report with the petitioner's qualifications and
26 MCFS recommendations included, at least two business days prior
27 to the hearing date. Parties may pick up this report from the
clerk during this time.

30 The Court may schedule two hearings: The first hearing to
determine whether or not a legal basis exists and the second
of

1 hearing to review the Guardianship Report recommendations and/or
2 other findings.

3 The Court will be making a determination at the hearing
4 which may affect the party's rights and responsibilities in
5 regard to the above-named child.

6 The parents, guardian and custodian of the youth are each
7 entitled to have someone represent them at this hearing at your
8 own expense - meaning that they will be solely responsible for
9 any fees charged by the person.

10 A facilitated Family Group Meeting will be made available
11 if requested by any party.

15 **FAILURE TO RESPOND OR TO APPEAR** may result in a default
16 judgment being entered against you without notice. A default
17 judgment is one where the petitioner is entitled to what he/she
18 asked for in the petition. If you or your spokesperson files a
19 Notice of Appearance with the court, you are entitled to notice
20 before a default judgment may be entered.
