



Things to Pray About for Oasis & our Visitation Ministries

As you prepare yourself for this time of prayer, first spend some time focusing on the Lord. Remember His attributes that are meaningful to you and worship Him for it. Ask Him to show you His glory that you might live to glorify Him. Invite Him to work in your life and pray for His glory and Kingdom to grow in you, through you, and through our church. You may also want to spend some time confessing sin to Him, thanking Him for the forgiveness and grace that we have in Christ.

If you run out of things to pray about during your 30 minutes, pray for boldness and power in ministry in a general way. There may be people in our church that you want to pray for - do that. There may also be people you know, love, or live among who don't know Jesus - pray for their salvation. Ultimately, we want to pray that God would be glorified and that His kingdom would grow, so pray as He leads you. Pray for His Spirit to move in us and through us and pray that we would have open minds and ready hearts to follow Him as He leads.

1. A Holy Spirit-Led Ministry

Pray that every aspect of these Ministries would be led by the Holy Spirit. May our leadership team continually seek God's direction through prayer, listen attentively for His voice, and have the faith and humility to follow where He leads. Give us hearts that are quick to listen to one another, recognizing that You often speak through each member of the team. May we discern Your will together with wisdom, unity, and grace so that everything we do brings glory to You.

3. Strong & Healthy Leaders

Pray for our leaders to be spiritually, emotionally, and physically strengthened. May they know the love of God for themselves and others in our community. Ask God to raise up new men and women who are willing to step into leadership as some of our members at Oasis age out of service.

4. **Purpose**

Pray that we encourage our seniors to connect with a greater sense of purpose within the congregation and our community.

5. **A Welcoming, Growing, and Hospitable Community**

Pray that every person who walks through our doors would feel genuinely welcomed, loved, and connected. May our Oasis Ministry be known as a place of warmth, kindness, and genuine hospitality, where every newcomer feels seen, valued, and loved.

6. **Wisdom for the Future**

Pray that God would continue to reveal His vision for the future of the Oasis Ministry, opening new doors and guiding every next step according to His purposes.

7. **Visitation Ministries**

Our visitation team also reaches out to the homebound who are/were members of CAC. Pray that CACers who are hurting would be seen, loved and feel supported in their times of need. Pray also that more people would volunteer in this important ministry. We have more people to visit than we have volunteers and would love to add to our team.

8. **Seniors Home Ministries**

Our care home services run at the Bradley Centre and Heritage Village once a month Sept – June. Pray for continued favour with the administration so that we can continue to minister to those who can no longer come to us for corporate worship. Pray that God would give us the words and the ways to communicate His Gospel love to those who are near the end of life and may be dealing with dementia, physical and sensory issues, and grief.
