



Things to Pray About for our Worship Ministry

As you prepare yourself for this time of prayer, first spend some time focusing on the Lord. Remember His attributes that are meaningful to you and worship Him for it. Ask Him to show you His glory that you might live to glorify Him. Invite Him to work in your life and pray for His glory and Kingdom to grow in you, through you, and through our church. You may also want to spend some time confessing sin to Him, thanking Him for the forgiveness and grace that we have in Christ.

If you run out of things to pray about during your 30 minutes, pray for boldness and power in ministry in a general way. There may be people in our church that you want to pray for - do that. There may also be people you know, love, or live among who don't know Jesus - pray for their salvation. Ultimately, we want to pray that God would be glorified and that His kingdom would grow, so pray as He leads you. Pray for His Spirit to move in us and through us and pray that we would have open minds and ready hearts to follow Him as He leads.

1. A Holy Spirit-Led Ministry

Pray that every aspect of our Worship Ministry would be led by the Holy Spirit. May our leadership team continually seek God's direction through prayer, listen attentively for His voice, and have the faith and humility to follow where He leads. Keep our hearts surrendered to Your plans and united in seeking Your will above our own preferences. Give us hearts that are quick to listen to one another, recognizing that You often speak through each member of the team. May we discern Your will together with wisdom, unity, and grace so that everything we do brings glory to You.

2. Unity Within the Worship Teams

Pray for deep unity, humility, and connection among the Worship Ministry leadership team. May they support one another, encourage one another, and lead worship with one heart and one vision as they seek to lead CAC to glorify God in song.

Pray that God would bring these musicians and tech leaders a passionate and singular purpose, vision, and direction.

3. Deeply Spiritual Leaders

Pray that every Worship Team member would grow in their personal relationship with Jesus, develop a deeper love for His Word, and become more rooted in prayer and daily discipleship. Pray that they would desire all-out surrender of their lives/families to Him. Pray that their love for Him would be evident in how they joyfully and authentically offer their service/gifts to Him as they serve Him during our Sunday morning worship experiences.

4. Raising the Next Generation of Leaders

Pray that God would prepare, equip, and open our eyes to younger musicians, vocalists, and tech lovers. Pray that people would step forward and become future members of our worship teams – ensuring that the ministry continues to flourish for years to come.

Pray that our youth group would nurture young talent in worship and tech.

5. Inspirational, Authentic Worship

Our service planning design team meets every Tuesday to review past services and plan future ones. Pray that they would hear God's voice and submit to His leading in planning the direction of services. Pray that the Lord would open their minds to the needs and heart of the congregation in worship to set the stage for engaging corporate worship on Sunday mornings.

Pray for a sense of the Spirit's presence during worship, and that our people would fall in love with Jesus and hunger to be at church to express that love to Him.

6. Growing Volunteers

Pray that our people would grow in their musicianship and their preparedness for service as an expression of worship and love to God. May they love to play and honour the Lord in all things!

Pray also that our tech teams would facilitate the Sunday mornings ministries. That in beautiful and unseen ways, they would expand and amplify all that happens at CAC in our worship times together.

7. Wisdom for the Future

Pray that God would continue to reveal His vision for the present and the future of music at CAC. That He would develop the 'language of the heart' of CAC, while leading us deep in lyrical theology. May our worship be full of grace, spirit, and truth.
