Thessalonians Women Bible Study – Start January, 20th 7–9 pm

In our upcoming Bible study, we will engage in a careful and in-depth reading of the First and Second Letters to the Thessalonians. This is not a brief devotional overview, but a thoughtful, verse-by-verse study that allows the text to unfold in its full theological, historical, and spiritual depth. We will take time to explore the background of each passage, its original meaning for the early church, and the enduring wisdom it offers for faith and daily life today, especially themes of perseverance, holiness, hope, and watchful expectation. No prior preparation is required. Please bring your Bible, a pen and a willingness to stay with the text, to ask questions, and to reflect deeply.
