GLOBAL UPDATE BY PASTOR HOLLY

Don and Betty Orr (Area Directors for Central Asia and Middle East teams): They are looking to travel back to Canada sometime between April 8-10, and plan to be here for about 3 months. They are awaiting approval from their leaders to leave then. Their local team is not feeling anxious in the midst of all that is happening in the area, so there is a high probability of them being able to leave well for this short time. Pray for approval, smooth travel (I imagine there are many delays), safety, as they make their way.

Peru (AIDIA, Luis Cervantes, Director): They continue to travel to remote villages to follow up with training and other initiatives, as well as seeking out new communities needing the Gospel, trained pastors/Sunday schools and leaders. Pray for the weather - they are near to the end of the rainy season, and it can make things treacherous. Pray for positive acceptance in some of these new villages who may not be keen on outsiders. They have a clean water initiative that helps them gain entrance to villages and part of that initiative is teaching, training, and gospel content.
