Peru (AIDIA, Luis Cervantes, director): So, this is cool. The translation team is helping out with another version of Quechua in the city of Puno (south Peru, situated on Lake Titicaca). Puno is a regional hub. Along with the translation work will eventually come pastoral training and development, and the development of kids and youth leaders and Sunday school-type programs. I have no idea what the faith situation is like there, but this opportunity will mean more good things for the growth of the Kingdom.

Pray for the translation team. It is grueling work. Pray for the reception of the translation and the components that will follow. Pray for the local church leaders, and for those God might be raising up to be part of promoting Scripture use and the expanding ministry opportunities that will arise. Pray for like-minded people who will work well together with whatever AIDIA is able to offer in the way of leadership and help for this area. This is more good news for Peru!
