Peru (AIDIA, Luis Cervantes, director): A little over a month ago, AIDIA staff traveled to the Mariscal Gamarra area for a weekend of training Sunday school teachers and leaders. They had 22 teachers/leaders from 12 different churches in the region. Pray for them as they now are teaching and implementing what they learned as they help kids understand God's word.

Continue to pray for their travel to remote rural communities, both for the traveling piece and the reception into these villages. Some villages have Christians, some don't. Pray also for other communities AIDIA staff have been involved in; holding trainings for both pastoral leadership and Sunday school leadership and program development. They have the Word in their Quechua dialect and want for many to know it and believe in Jesus. May it be so.
