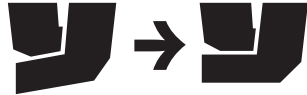


OpenType Features

Select **Baseline 'Q'** to remove overhang.



Select **Baseline 'Y'** to remove overhang.



Select **Standing 'Y'** for a typical stance.



Select **Seven no crossbar** for the open seven.



Select **Raised colon** for use with caps and lining figures.



Select **Fractions** for pre-built fractions.



Select the **Numero sign** to replace the number sign with Numero.



Select **Capital punctuation** for raised punctuation to use with caps and Lining Figures.



Turn on **Ligatures** to better manage awkward character combinations.



Turn on **Discretionary Ligatures** to use the extended ligature set.
