


WHAT IS MIFTAAH + MYNA?

POWERPOINTS


When available, course PowerPoints are provided on the student portal. PowerPoints are custom made by the Miftaah team and cover only the necessary topics and information needed to complete the program.

After completing 8 courses, students are encouraged to transfer to the Miftaah Online Program.


