

# 3C Patch® Wound Management System

A fully autologous 3-layer leukocyte, platelet, and fibrin patch

## Physician Office/Home Reimbursement Guide

Effective for claims with dates of service on or after April 13, 2021, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) created Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) code G0465.

**HCPCS G0465** Autologous platelet rich plasma (prp) or other blood-derived product for diabetic chronic wounds/ulcers, using an fda-cleared device for this indication, (includes as applicable administration, dressings, phlebotomy, centrifugation or mixing, and all other preparatory procedures per treatment)

This code is appropriate to report the administration of the **3C Patch** (including preparatory procedures) for the treatment of chronic non-healing diabetic wounds under the conditions and criteria set forth in NCD 270.3.

**HCPCS code G0465** is appropriate to report physician office charges (e.g., if the procedure is performed in the office) as well as for home services (e.g., if the procedure is performed at home) for the below-described procedure.
