Days 1-2: Santa Cruz

Arrive in Santa Cruz and explore the Samaipata Ruins, a pre-Inca ceremonial fortress perched on a hilltop. Wander the charming town of Samaipata, visit its local museum, and discover this hidden gem before returning to Santa Cruz.

Day 3: Santa Cruz - Sucre

Fly to Sucre, Bolivia's UNESCO-listed colonial city. Visit Casa de la Libertad, stroll through Bolivar Park, and explore La Recoleta and the ASUR Museum of Indigenous Textiles.

Day 4: Sucre

Enjoy a full free day to wander Sucre's cobbled streets, lively markets, and charming cafés at your own pace.

Day 5: Sucre - Potosi

Travel to historic Potosí, a UNESCO World Heritage Site once famed for its silver mines.

Explore its colonial streets, visit the San Francisco and San Lorenzo churches, and descend into the Cerro Rico mines for an unforgettable glimpse into Bolivia's past.

Day 6: Potosi - Uyuni - Villamar

Journey south towards Uyuni, passing highland valleys, ancient mining towns, and stone formations shaped by centuries of erosion. Visit the train cemetery and picturesque villages before arriving in Villamar for the night.

Day 7: Villamar - Colorful Lagoons - San Juan

Explore the Eduardo Abaroa National Reserve, home to surreal landscapes and vibrant wonders: the emerald waters of Laguna Verde and flamingo-filled Laguna Colorada, the dramatic Arbol de Piedra rock formations and steaming Sol de Mañana geysers. Continue to San Juan via scenic highland lagoons.

Day 8: San Juan - Uyuni Salt Flats - Colchani

Venture into the otherworldly Uyuni Salt Flats and cross to Isla Incahuasi, dotted with giant cacti and volcanic rock. Enjoy a private picnic on the salt flats before heading to Colchani to witness local salt production and a stunning sunset.

Day 9: Uyuni - La Paz - Copacabana - Sun Island

Fly to La Paz and continue to Lake Titicaca. Explore Copacabana and take a scenic boat ride to the Island of the Sun, where you'll enjoy a traditional Aptapi meal before hiking to the Pilko Kaina Ruins and your lodge for the night.

Day 10: Sun Island

Spend a leisurely day discovering the island's tranquil beauty, ancient ruins, and sweeping views over Lake Titicaca.

Day 11: Moon Island - Copacabana - La Paz

Catch the sunrise over Sun Island, visit the Inca Stairs and Water of Eternal Youth, then continue by boat to Moon Island to explore the Inak Uyu Temple before returning to La Paz.

Days 12-13: La Paz

Experience La Paz like a local with a guided tour led by a "lustra bota" shoe-shiner guide, discovering markets and hidden streets. Ride the teleférico cable cars for sweeping city views and wander through the Witches' Market to uncover Andean traditions. The next day, prepare for your flight home.
