

#### Days 4-5: Drake's Passage

Cross the legendary Drake Passage, a rite of passage for polar explorers. Spot albatrosses, petrels, and possibly whales as you enter Antarctic waters.

#### **Days 6-11: White Continent**

Explore the untouched wilderness of Antarctica, where every day brings a new adventure:

- Neumayer Channel & Wiencke Island
   — Zodiac cruises, kayaking,
   snowshoeing, and soft-climb
   mountaineering.
- Port Lockroy Visit a historic British station, meet gentoo penguins, and explore Jougla Point.
- Pléneau & Petermann Islands —
  Watch for Adélie penguins, whales,
  and leopard seals as you kayak past
  glaciers and icebergs.
- Neko Harbour & Paradise Bay —
   Experience Zodiac landings and, if conditions allow, camp overnight under the Antarctic sky.
- Errera Channel Possible visits to Danco, Cuverville, or Orne Islands, home to diverse seabirds and penguin colonies.

#### Days 12-13: Drake's Passage

Sail back through the Drake Passage, enjoying stunning seabird sightings.

#### Day 14: Ushuaia

Disembark in Ushuaia after breakfast and transfer to the airport for your onward journey, carrying memories of one of the world's most extraordinary expeditions.
