### Day 1: Bhutan

### Day 3: Dochula Pass

Journey through the Dochula Pass at 3,100 meters, offering sweeping views of the Himalayan range. Visit Chimi Lhakhang (Fertility Temple) and cross the Pho Chu Suspension Bridge, with stunning vistas of Punakha Dzong and the river valley below.

### Day 4: Khamsum Yuley Temple

Visit the exquisite Khamsum Yuley Temple, built by the Queen Mother for global peace. Continue to Sangchhen Dorji Lhuendrup Nunnery, perched on a scenic ridge, home to impressive statues and Bhutan's timeless architecture.

### Day 5: Paro Valley

Explore Paro Valley, dotted with ancient temples and monasteries. Visit Kyichu Lhakhang, one of Bhutan's oldest and most sacred temples, before strolling through Paro town to discover local shops, handicrafts, and cafés.

### Day 6: Taktsang Monastery

Hike to the legendary Taktsang Monastery, dramatically perched on a cliffside above Paro Valley. One of Bhutan's most iconic landmarks, this sacred site offers a truly transformative experience.

### Day 7: Paro

Bid farewell to Bhutan's serene beauty as you transfer to the airport for your flight home.
