RESIDENTIAL SERVICE TIME OF USE OPTIONAL RATE SCHEDULE "RSTOU-6"

AVAILABILITY

Available in all territory served by the Cooperative on a voluntary basis, subject to the Terms and Conditions of the Cooperative on file with the West Virginia Public Service Commission.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to Members of the Cooperative for single phase and three-phase residential and residential/farms, schools, seasonal services, ball fields, churches and community halls.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Single-phase, or three-phase if available at Member's service location, 60 cycles, at available secondary voltages.

ON-PEAK AND OFF-PEAK ENERGY

On-Peak Energy for the billing periods from June through September is defined as kWh used between 2 p.m. to 8 p.m. For the months between October and May On-Peak Energy is defined as kWh used between 6 a.m. and 9 a.m. and between 4 p.m. and 8 p.m.

MINIMUM MONTHLY DISTRIBUTION DELIVERY CHARGE

The minimum monthly charge for distribution delivery service under the above rate shall be the applicable Consumer Delivery Charge.

BILLING DEMAND

The billing demand shall be the Customer's maximum kilowatt integrated demand measured for any 60-minute clock hour period from 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. during the month for which the bill is rendered.
