June's permit total was 197 and 31 of those were new addresses.

Clearwater Utilities has just completed some repairs in Avalon Terrace under our maintenance contract. They replaced a failing manhole along with close to 400 feet of sewer pipe that was failing due to bellies in those lines. There were several residents that were experiencing repeated backups and overflows due to these issues.

Our maintenance and operations crews have been working hard to keep up with regular maintenance issues and repairing occasional damage from boring crews and other wear and tear failures.

V. FINANCIAL REPORT AND REVIEW. (RANDI MATTHEWS)

Interest income is down as we expected and there were some expenses this month for legal and accounting fees, along with some lift station repairs. There were also some expenses that went to Tangipahoa Parish Government for the new storage building that we split with the parish. We also had some reimbursements from the water sector grant, bringing us to a net loss for the month of \$180,563.00. Year to date we are just under our budgeted amount by around \$12,000.00, making us in the red for the year. (Jason) We are all reimbursed for the Water Sector round 2 but the bank statements do not reflect these reimbursements for the month.

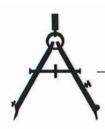

4. Water Sector Program (Division of Administration) - Phase 2:

c. Ponchatoula High School Regional WWTP Improvements

- i. A meeting was held between Tangipahoa Parish School System (TPSS), TPSD, and Spangler Engineering. Of the \$1,842,100 grant award, TPSD will be responsible for \$1,215,786 (66%) and TPSS will be responsible for \$626,314 (34%). The total project award is \$7,085,000.
- ii. The project involves constructing a new 300,000 GPD, three-cell aerated lagoon at Ponchatoula High School. It includes the consolidation and closure of two existing TPSD WWTPs: Brookfield WWTP (currently under a DEQ compliance order) and Pecan Trace WWTP.
- iii. The two existing WWTPs will be decommissioned and consolidated via force mains into the new WWTP at Ponchatoula High School.

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- iv. TPSS will donate the property and TPSD will assume responsibility for the new treatment facility upon project completion.
- v. Awaiting soil boring information; Jurisdictional determination (JD) has been submitted to USACOE for review/approval; USACOE permitting will follow. Applying for an expedited *preliminary* permit limit determination from LADEQ.

- a. Green Acres WWTP Improvements (DEQ Compliance) -
 - Potential tie-in from TPSS. Consolidation of Hammond Eastside and Hammond High. Capacity fee and tie-in information has been provided to TPSS.

- d. Airport Road Lift Station & Force Main Improvements
 - i. Construction in progress (43.36% Complete; 75% Contract Time)
 - ii. Contractor is currently fusing and boring force main beginning at Gorman Road proceeding south toward the lift station site. Contractor has installed 5,257 linear feet of 6" FM (2,643 LF remaining). Pumps and controls to be supplied by TPSD. Wet well has been installed. Well pointing has been installed for gravity sewer installation to Miller Lane LS. Spangler Eng and Entergy met regarding "best fit" route for new electrical service. Daily weather has impacted construction schedule.
 - iii. Recommend approval of Partial Pay Estimate No. Three (3) for \$110,972.92 (TPSD \$110,972.92)
 - iv. Recommend approval of Additive Change Order No. One (1) for \$172,800.00 for inclusion of 12" gravity sewer to Airport Road, based on current available property access from Southern Tire Mart and long-term development along Airport Road corridor.
