The Oratory Church of St Wilfrid is a Jubilee Pilgrimage Church for the Holy Year 2025. A Plenary Indulgence, applicable to the faithful departed, may be gained each day by a devout visit to the church, together with prayers for the Holy Father's intentions, Holy Communion and sacramental Confession within a few days, and detachment from sin.



Today is the last day of the Holy Year (outside of Rome, where it ends at Epiphany) and so the last day on which you may gain the Jubilee Indulgence in our church.

BISHOPS' MOVE

The Holy Father has accepted the resignation of the Rt Revd Terence Patrick Drainey as Bishop of Middlesbrough. The Fathers and Brothers would like to express their special gratitude to Bishop Drainey for inviting them to make a foundation in York.

The Bishop of Leeds, the Rt Revd Marcus Stock, has been appointed by Pope Leo XIV as Apostolic Administrator of the Diocese of Middlesbrough. Bishop Stock writes,

"It is the Holy Father's wish that I explore with the clergy, lay faithful and religious of our two historic sister Dioceses of Middlesbrough and Leeds how we might journey together in mission, work in close collaboration and gain from each other's strengths in order to secure the future of the Church's witness to Christ across the regions we serve."

WEDNESDAY, 4 FEBRUARY VISIT OF THE RELICS OF ST GERARD MAJELLA

The relics of St Gerard Majella will be visiting our church, and the Redemptorist priest Fr Royston Price will celebrate Mass and preach at 7pm. St Gerard Majella is the patron saint of mothers, expectant mothers, childbirth, children (especially the unborn), and those struggling with infertility, often called "The Mothers' Saint" due to numerous miracles associated with pregnancy and family. St Gerard (1726–1755) was an Italian Redemptorist lay brother known for his deep humility, obedience, and miraculous intercession.
