Call to Order

Ms. Kim Tran and Mr. Syrus Lee called the meeting to order at 6:17 pm.

1. Approval of the 25th AGM Minutes

Motion: That the Minutes of the AGM held on September 11, 2024, be adopted.

Moved/Seconded: Henry Tom & Lawrence Lee. Motion carried by show of hands. All in favour.

2. Review of the Vancouver Chinatown BIA activities for 2024-2025

Mr. Jordan Eng, current President reported on the year in review –

Mr. Eng, welcomed everyone for attending Vancouver Chinatown Business Area Society's Annual General Meeting. Mr. Eng thanked Ms. Kim Tran and Mr. Syrus Lee to MC the Annual General Meeting. Mr. Eng would also like to recognize Ms. Joey Kwan, Executive Director, and the Board of Directors that were in attendance: Ms. Kim Tran, Vice-President, Mr. Chris Chan, Treasurer, Mr. Syrus Lee, Director of Operations, Mr. Henry Tom, Mr. Ross Lam, and Mr. Jason Yuen.

Mr. Eng noted the mandate for the VCBIA is to promote the common interest of both property and business owners in the neighbourhood. The VCBIA Board of Directors is composed of elected members from the local business and property owners' community. The primary role of the Board is to provide strategic direction for policies and programs for the organization. The Board also provides oversight on the implementation of those policies and programs at its monthly Board meetings. This is a voluntary position and as a working Board, directors contribute with their knowledge and expertise spending often many hours outside of their day jobs. Very often, the Executive Director will ask Directors to volunteer to assist with program delivery to both raise the community profile of the Board and to stretch the BIA budget. Working with the City of Vancouver's BIA Program Coordinator, and adhering to BIA best practices, the VCBIA Board of Directors, implemented a Code of Conduct Policy in 2018. All Board of Directors are required to sign this Code of Conduct. VCBIA continues to be a strong voice for the community advocating not only for the members, but the community and the neighbourhood as a whole. Cooperation and partnership strengthens impact and leverages capacity.

The year in review – the following is a snapshot of the highlights for the last year.

In previous years, VCBIA was one of the organizers with the Army, Navy and Airforce in hosting the Remembrance Day Service at the Chinatown Memorial. This last year VCBIA continued to play a supporting role in this very important event.

In November, along with the Vancouver Chinatown Merchants Association, VCBIA hosted CHINATOWN SOCIAL Hour which was co-sponsored by Dr. Sun Yat-Sen Classic Chinese Garden, was a casual meet and greet for the members. It was attended by Mr. Freddy Lau and Mr. Byron Yee of the Vancouver Police who came to speak to the group and there was an open mic for business owners to introduce themselves.



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The Lunar New Year was launched with a big social media promotion and supported by a sponsorship from Enbridge. Included in the promotion was the popular Collect 4, Snap, Post tattoo contest. VCBIA moved away from the more traditional Fai Chun design with a playful update. VCBIA was front and center at the Lunar New Year parade with continued support as a sponsor. Despite the snowy start, 10s of thousands of visitors still showed up.

Early June, VCBIA hosted the annual Chinatown Clean Up event with over 200 volunteers and supporting organizations from across the city.

VCBIA continued political advocacy and took Mr. Jamie Stein and Mr. Ralph Kaiser, ABC candidates in the by-election for a local meet and greet. With the civic election less than a year away VCBIA expects to ramp up again in the New Year.

Last year's AGM, VCBIA spoke of City Council support of the Chinatown Cultural District Framework.

Of importance was that:

- Chinatown would be recognized as a distinct cultural neighbourhood, both from a physical and planning perspective; the first of its kind in Vancouver.
- The Framework is a comprehensive approach to support the neighbourhood from its most urgent needs to responding to key priorities for long-term planning.
- The working group of stakeholders include many legacy organizations and representation from cultural, heritage, residential, and business interests.
- The whole city approach to planning in Chinatown with City staff support and a Council liaison will create more effective community engagement and implementation of community led initiatives.

This last year, the program was implemented with the establishment of the Chinatown Advisory Committee of which Mr. Eng and Ms. Carol Lee are the Co-chairs.

VCBIA's much anticipated and signature event, Chinatown Festival, was held on the weekend of July 12th and 13th. VCBIA was blessed with hot weather, and the streets were packed. Families, young people and seniors from across the city enjoying a fun-filled weekend. VCBIA was excited to welcome BMO as the title sponsor. The festival has not had a title sponsor for several years and is in the process of securing them for next year. The team always looks to bring in new activities, performances and new ideas to enhance the visitor experience.

Another significant project this year was Chinatown Reimagined with the Vancouver Chinatown Merchants Association which focused on the Chinatown Plaza. With consultants Dunefield, this project involved working with a large group of Chinatown business owners – visioning, consulting with the community, and designing. The next step was to establish a working group through the Chinatown Advisory Group to implement, there will be much work to do in the coming year.

VCBIA played a supporting role with the VPD Foundation funded Project Muralize spearheaded by Constable Freddy Lau which plans on 10 murals on storefronts created by local artists, to replace and prevent the ongoing graffiti tagging. VCBIA continued to work with City staff on the "Uplift Chinatown" program with other stakeholders and organizations in the neighbourhood.

Conclusion

The VCBIA Board will continue to explore different ways to support the members and thank them for their support. Mr. Eng is proud to work with a dedicated team of Board members and volunteers who generously donated countless hours to the community and the hard-working staff that made it happen. Mr. Eng would like to Thank you our departing Board member Mr. Edmund Ma, representing the Mah's Association for his 8+ years of service.

Mr. Kelly Kellogg, Property Manager, on behalf of MYER-BEA HOLDINGS LTD, asked about the Security Budget rate not having an increase. Ms. Serena Chu, Owner of CHU CHU, asked about the details of the Security Patrol and SafeWalk statistics. Mr. Eng and Ms. Joey Kwan both replied that the VCBIA has security and SafeWalk statistics and the details have been reported back to the City of Vancouver on a regular basis. Ms. Siobian Smith noted a mistake with the Rent expense being misrepresented on the VCBIA Proposed Plan & Budget for 2026-2027.
