## Monday 22nd September Day 1

**In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord, high and exalted, seated on a throne; and the train of his robe filled the temple. Above him were seraphim, each with six wings: With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they were flying. 3 And they were calling to one another: "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory." At the sound of their voices the doorposts and thresholds shook and the temple was filled with smoke. "Woe to me!" I cried. "I am ruined! For I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips, and my eyes have seen the King, the Lord Almighty." Then one of the seraphim flew to me with a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with tongs from the altar. With it he touched my mouth and said, "See, this has touched your lips; your guilt is taken away and your sin atoned for." Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?" And I said, "Here am I. Send me!" Isaiah 6:1-8**

### Prayer Points

- (Jn15) Cut away what doesn't belong in my life, prune what is unfruitful in my heart and in our churches. In your mercy give us revelation, wisdom, like-minded friends and strategic partnerships to go into all the world according to your master plan.
- Local/ National/ Global mission: Pray for Mums, Dads and families in your town/city. Lift up to God all MPs and those serving in our parliamentary system. Pray for Julian and Monica Hawken (China, NZ based) Robert and Margaret Hunt (Philippines, NZ based) Paul and Jung-Dae Lee (Turkey)

## Tuesday 23rd September *Day 2*

**“For “Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.” But how can they call on him to save them unless they believe in him? And how can they believe in him if they have never heard about him? And how can they hear about him unless someone tells them? And how will anyone go and tell them without being sent? That is why the Scriptures say, “How beautiful are the feet of messengers who bring good news!” Romans 10:13–15**

### Prayer Points

## Wednesday 24th September *Day 3*

**“I am a special messenger from Christ Jesus to you Gentiles. I bring you the Good News so that I might present you as an acceptable offering to God, made holy by the Holy Spirit.”  
Romans 15:16**

### Prayer Points

- Father we thank you for giving us a word to speak to our communities that is alive and active. That our voices can loose what is sharper than any double-edged sword.
- We pray your words through us would penetrate even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow, judging the thoughts and attitudes of the heart of those who hear.
- We declare that in coming years throughout all our churches the full gospel or words and deeds will be preached. That signs and wonders will follow the powerful authoritative proclamation of the cross and resurrection of Jesus Christ.
- Holy Spirit we praise you for enabling us to stand in the gap between you and the unbelieving world. Teach us and lead us to increasingly become a house of prayer so all the nations of the world can find their home in you.
- Our God we ask you to expand and deepen our capacity to pray for the non-believers we share life with. That the fallow ground of the communities you have sent us to would be plowed by our prayers.

### Prayer Points

# Day 5

### Prayer Points

### Prayer Points

- We declare that going forward the Assemblies of God in NZ will see itself as a labour force being thrust out into the ripe harvest. That our identity would be 'God's workers, a house of people built together by Him for the gathering of the nations'.
- We thank you for the raising up and sending of Apostolic, Prophetic, Evangelistic, Shepherding and Teaching gifts throughout our movement. We thank you for humility and love toward one another that makes way for, and prefers, the other person's gifts.
- Local/ National/ Global mission: Pray for hope to arise in the hearts of the addicted and the depressed in your city/town. Pray that throughout Aotearoa the hearts of the children will be turned to the fathers and the hearts of the fathers be turned to the children. ## Monday 29th September

# Day 8

### Prayer Points

# Day 9

### Prayer Points

# Day 10

### Prayer Points

- We give thanks for the zealous love for the Lord Jesus that motivated our spiritual mothers and fathers to lay down their lives for a Holy Spirit/ Pentecostal witness in Aotearoa.
- Father God, we ask that as you did when you lit the first flame of Pentecost on our shores... you would once again cause first-love to arise... and show us where the fear of what others think has bound us.
- Lord Jesus we give you thanks that the fire of Pentecost is burning in men, women, boys and girls of every tongue, tribe and generation in our land. We thank you Holy Spirit that you have found a home in us and we have found a home in you.
- We declare the multicultural, intergenerational, interdependent blessing of the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ over our conference and over our movement in the years to come.
- We declare a new era of faith and hope in Jesus Christ for Aotearoa NZ. That a new song will arise on the lips of New Zealanders, a song that rejoices in the goodness of God and in what Jesus has done.
- Local/ National/ Global mission: Declare a blessing and an outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon upper South Island. Ask God to protect and anoint Ps Ross Ferguson and the other pastors in that region. Pray blessing, courage, provision and wisdom for our Exec member and Te Roopu Maori leader Ps Mina and Dennis Acraman. Declare a double-portion blessing over all our Maori churches and the release of Maori church-planters. Pray for Solomon and Sola Chand (Nauru)
- J and C M (Indonesia) Hamish and Haidee Betts (Singapore).

## Thursday 2nd October

# Day 11

**But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”**  
**Acts 1:8**

### Prayer Points

- Father God we thank you for the sending of the Holy Spirit, for the Wonderful Counsellor, our mission strategist, who gives us your mighty power within us to defeat the works of the devil.
- We declare a mighty and continual outpouring of the Holy Spirit in New Zealand. That you will renew and transform your church into a new wine skin fit for a new wine.
- We declare the planting of new churches and new faith communities. That in coming years you will fill that wine skin with a new wine given for the making of disciples. Disciples who will be sent to reap the harvest and to disciple the nations.
- We declare the breaking of bondages, curses, addictions, sicknesses and diseases by the blood of Jesus. We plead the blood of Jesus over our whenua (land). In the name of Jesus we bind the enemies of God, tear down strong holds and command demons to go.
- Local/ National/ Global mission: Declare a blessing and an outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the Wellington Region. Ask God to protect and anoint Ps Paul White and the other pastors in that region. Pray for pastor Paul White as he champions men in our movement, pray that God would raise up men of spiritual might and power to serve in their families, neighbourhoods, churches and workplaces. Pray blessing, courage, provision and wisdom for our Exec member Ps Mike and Michelle Coe. Give grace and authority to raise up and release church planters and pioneers of new territory. Pray for Philip and Sarah Hawken (Kenya) Dave and Heidi Fraser (Cambodia).



## Friday 3rd October *Day 12*

**“So we are Christ’s ambassadors;  
God is making his appeal through us.  
We speak for Christ when we plead,  
“Come back to God!”” 2 Corinthians 5:20**

### Prayer Points

- Father God we bow before you, we give you honour, praise and all the glory for what you have done and for what you have promised to do in our families, in our towns/cities, in our churches and in our nation.
- We marvel that you are weaving us together and doing a new thing in our movement. Father continue to have your way amongst us, complete what you have started, be gracious to us at conference and in the coming years. For your name’s sake do a deep work in us.
- Our God we give you thanks for the people of the land. Thank you for Tangata whenua who heard and embraced the gospel and were sent out preaching the word and planting churches. We thank you for the revival fires that once swept through iwi (tribes) and hapu (sub-tribes). Holy Spirit we ask you to blow on those embers. We call (karanga) Maori from every tribe in the motu (nation) to come to Jesus and find life in his name.
- Lord Jesus we thank you for fresh vision and new strategies to make disciples and to plant churches. We pray that throughout our churches the cry of the broken, the hurting, the addicted, the homeless, would be seen with soft eyes and heard with compassion. “Send me Lord, send me with love, send me with grace, send me on faith adventures with the power to set the captives free”.
- Local/ National/ Global mission: Declare a blessing and an outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the West Coast North Island. Ask God to protect and anoint Ps Paul Cornish and the other pastors in that region. Pray for Ps Pip Batten as she champions women in our movement, pray that God would raise up women of spiritual might and power to serve in their families, neighbourhoods, churches and workplaces. Pray blessing, courage, provision and wisdom for our Exec member Ps Sanjai and Sunitha Kandregula.

## Saturday 4th October *Day 13*

**Come, I will send you to Pharaoh that you may bring my people, the children of Israel, out of Egypt.” But Moses said to God, “Who am I that I should go to Pharaoh and bring the children of Israel out of Egypt?” He said, “But I will be with you, and this shall be the sign for you, that I have sent you: when you have brought the people out of Egypt, you shall serve God on this mountain.”  
Exodus 3:10-12**

### Prayer Points

- Lord of the harvest we hear your call to us. We the Assemblies of God in NZ have counted the cost and we say “Yes”. We will go as Apostles. We will go as Prophets. We will go as Evangelists. We will go as Shepherds (Pastors) and we will go as Teachers.
- As you were sent Lord Jesus we send one another. We thank you, and we receive that portion of yourself in each of us given for the blessing of others.
- Forgive us Lord Jesus, for over looking each other, under valuing one another and misusing the gifts you have given. Give us fresh eyes to see, and fresh ears to hear one another.
- We look to our left and to our right. We see, we release and we call forth Apostles, Prophets, Evangelists, Shepherds and Teachers. We declare a new era for the Assemblies of God in NZ; we see the synergy of these five gifts being sent into the harvest, we see a sustained revival and the job of disciple making being done for decades to come.
- Local/ National/ Global mission: Declare a blessing and an outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the East Coast North Island. Ask God to protect and anoint Ps Sajan Easow and the other pastors in that region. Pray that our movement would be a house of safety a joy for multitudes of children. Declare the discipling of children through our churches. Uphold Ps Sarah Coupe as she leads us and in her role administering our finances and levies in the National Office.



## Sunday 5th October

# Day 14

Then Moses said to God, "If I come to the people of Israel and say to them, 'The God of your fathers has sent me to you,' and they ask me, 'What is his name?' what shall I say to them?" God said to Moses, "I am who I am." And he said, "Say this to the people of Israel: 'I am has sent me to you.'" Exodus 3:13-14

### Prayer Points

- Be led by the Holy Spirit and take these words from 1 Pet 2 (below) and repeat them as a declaration over individuals, towns, churches and nations..... Insert the names of people, your town/city, your church and nations etc, into the brackets [ ] as you are led.
- ...For you [ ] are a chosen people. You [ ] are royal priests, a holy nation, God's very own possession. As a result, you [ ] can show others the goodness of God, for he called you [ ] out of the darkness into his wonderful light and has sent you to do great exploits in his mighty name.
- Local/ National/ Global mission: Declare a blessing and an outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the Bay of Plenty. Ask God to protect and anoint Ps Dennis and Mina Acraman and the other pastors in that region. Pray blessing, courage, provision and wisdom for our Exec member Ps Joseph and Lisa McCauley
- Pray for the peace of Jerusalem and for revival in Israel. That Jesus would be embraced as the Messiah and celebrated as the fulfilment of the ancient promises to the Jewish people.

## Monday 6th October

# Day 15

And the Lord turned to him and said, "Go in this might of yours and save Israel from the hand of Midian; do not I send you?" And he said to him, "Please, Lord, how can I save Israel? Behold, my clan is the weakest in Manasseh, and I am the least in my father's house." And the Lord said to him, "But I will be with you, and you shall strike the Midianites as one man." Judges 6:14-16

### Prayer Points

- Give us grace oh God, that a steadfast faith would arise throughout our Movement. We commit to 'Being strong and courageous. To not being afraid; and not being discouraged'. Give us eyes to see that the 'Lord our God is with us everywhere we go' (Josh1:9, Matt 28).
- Make us constantly aware that 'greater are those that are with us than those who are against us' (2 Ki 6:16).
- Forgive us Father for having limited ourselves to our own self understanding. Forgive us for having restricted our expectations of what we can accomplish to our past experiences. We repent, we turn to you asking for a deeper revelation of you and your power within us.
- We declare a new era of bold faith for mission arising in the hearts of young and old. An era of quick obedience to new strategies, to Holy Spirit promptings and to allowing the power of God to flow through us.
- We say of our God that he is the strength and shield of the Assemblies of God in NZ. That it is the Lord of the Harvest who watches over us night and day to lead and guide as we more than double our influence and footprint before 2033.
- Local/ National/ Global mission: Declare a blessing and an outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the Waikato. Ask God to protect and anoint Ps Carolien Moxham and the other pastors in that region. Pray blessing, courage, provision and wisdom for our Exec member Ps Paul and Kerry Gordon.

Tuesday 7th October

*Day 16*

**'Now get up and stand on your feet. I have appeared to you to appoint you as a servant and as a witness of what you have seen and will see of me. I will rescue you from your own people and from the Gentiles. I am sending you to them.**  
**Acts 26:16-17**

## Prayer Points

- Lord Jesus we receive what you have done for us, you have touched our lips with a coal and made us your sent people. We accept the responsibility, we are your people who are called by your name.
- We the Assemblies of God in NZ, humble ourselves and we pray.
- We humble ourselves and we seek your face. We turn from our wicked ways, from everything earthly, unspiritual and demonic.
- In your great mercy hear from heaven as we cry out on behalf of those we are sent to. Forgive our sins and restore our land. Open your eyes and ears and be attentive to every prayer we pray.
- We declare the Spirit of Wisdom from above for the leaders of our Movement and of our nation. The Holy Spirit given wisdom that is first of all pure, that is also peace loving, is gentle at all times, and willing to yield to others. A wisdom that is full of mercy and the fruit of good deeds. A wisdom that shows no favouritism and is always sincere (James 3).
- We declare the rising up of peacemakers throughout our movement and throughout Aotearoa NZ. Peacemakers who will plant seeds of peace and reap a harvest of righteousness.
- Local/ National/ Global mission: Declare a blessing and an outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the Auckland region. Ask God to protect and anoint Pastors Binuraj and Chris Sola and all the other pastors in that region. Pray blessing, courage, provision and wisdom for our Exec member and leader of the Tongan ethnic group Ps Anahina and Vosailangi Sikalu. Declare a double-portion blessing over all our Tongan churches and the release of Tongan church-planters. Pray blessing, courage, provision and wisdom for our Indian ethnic leader Ps Binuraj. Declare a double-portion blessing over all our Indian churches and the release of Indian church-planters.

Wednesday 8th October

## Prayer Points

An army of young people set alight in the power of the Holy Spirit and a love for Jesus that will not back down in front of giants. Uphold Ps Jamie and Rebekah Chapman, ask God for every blessing from above as they lead the Fearless movement. Pray blessing, courage, provision and wisdom for our Cook Island ethnic leader and Events manager Ps Ani and Reea Tangimataiti. Declare a double-portion blessing over all our Cook Island churches and the release of Cook Island church-planters.

## Friday 10th October

# Day 19

After this the Lord appointed seventy-two others and sent them two by two ahead of him to every town and place where he was about to go. - Local/ National/ Global mission: Pray blessing, courage, provision and wisdom for our National Secretary and MM33 point person Ps Darren and Sharon Gammie. Give thanks for and lift up to God Ps Darren and our National Office Staff, Ani, Sarah, Edwina and Angela. Ask for grace, wisdom and strength as they serve us with essential support and communications.

# Day 21


