DAY 20

“Three times I pleaded with the Lord to take it away from me. But he said to me, “My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.” Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ’s power may rest on me. That is why, for Christ’s sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong.” 2 Corinthians 12:8–10

Prayer Points

- Lord Jesus I fall to my knees and I thank you for seeing me in my weakness and saying to me, “Come, follow me and I will make you a fisher of men”. Father in heaven cause a spirit of intercession and deepening love to arise in our movement. That in every situation and in before every difficulty we would never stop praying for each other.
- That we would always be strengthening one another by the laying on of hands. Fill one another with the knowledge of your will through all spiritual wisdom and understanding (Colossians 1:9).

Monday 31st August

DAY 1

“Do you not know? Have you not heard? The Lord is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He will not grow tired or weary, and his understanding no one can fathom. He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak. Even youths grow tired and weary, and young men stumble and fall; but those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. Prayer Points

Lift up to God all MPs and those serving in our parliamentary system, uphold by name those who represent your electorate. Pray for God’s protection of the coming election– that men and women of principle and integrity would be elected to the NZ parliament.
Pray for Ps Freedom Aiga as he champions men in our movement, pray that God would raise up men of spiritual might and power to serve in their families, neighbourhoods, churches and workplaces. Pray for Julian and Monica Hawken (East Asia, NZ based) Robert and Margaret Hunt (Philippines, NZ based), P and J L (Middle East).

Tuesday 1st September

DAY 2

“When David and his men reached Ziklag, they found it destroyed by fire and their wives and sons and daughters taken captive. So David and his men wept aloud until they had no strength left to weep. David’s two wives had been captured—Ahinoam of Jezreel and Abigail, the widow of Nabal of Carmel. David was greatly distressed because the men were talking of stoning him; each one was bitter in spirit because of his sons and daughters. But David found strength in the Lord his God. Prayer Points

- We declare that through our sharing of the Good News, the footprint and influence of the Assemblies of God in NZ will more than double in Aotearoa by 2033... that our movement will be a well spring of blessing to our nation and other movements.
- Local/ National/ Global mission:

Friday 18th September

DAY 19

“Blessed is the one who does not walk in step with the wicked or stand in the way that sinners take or sit in the company of mockers, but whose delight is in the law of the Lord, and who meditates on his law day and night. That person is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither—whatever they do prospers.” Psalm 1:1–3

Prayer Points

- Lord Jesus we pray the Assembly of God movement in NZ would day and night be drawing strength from your word.

DAY 18

"I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want. I can do all this through him who gives me strength." Philippians 4:12-13

Prayer Points

- Father God, we open our hearts to continually receive what you have breathed in the vision of MM33. Thank you for the oneness and agreement heard by the "Yes" of Assembly of God churches from every continent.
- We thank you that at such a time as this we have a part to play. A time when it seemed good for us and the Holy Spirit to be deliberately expanding us as a global movement in cities/ towns/ villages and nations around the world.
- We pray that in our movement of churches the cross of Christ will be lifted high. That your love will overflow more and more into every neighbourhood. That we will keep on growing in spiritual knowledge and understanding. That in the soil of our continued humility you will grow us in our understanding of what really matters to you. That we would live faithfully, pure and blameless until the day of Christ's return.

DAY 3

Prayer Points

- Father God, we thank you for giving us strength and courage to speak a word to our communities that is alive and active. That we can speak on your behalf binding and loosing so that your will is done on earth as it is in heaven.

Prayer Points

- Lord Jesus, I look and I behold you today. I see you high and lifted up, my champion and the victor over my enemies.

Wednesday 16th September

DAY 17

But you, Israel, my servant, Jacob, whom I have chosen, you descendants of Abraham my friend, I took you from the ends of the earth, from its farthest corners I called you. I said, ‘You are my servant’; I have chosen you and have not rejected you. So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.” Isaiah 41: 8–10

Prayer Points

- Father God, we thank you for your incredible faithfulness to the worldwide Assemblies of God movement. For the corporate grace and unity to envision ourselves doubled by the year 2033.

Tuesday 15th September

DAY 16

"Yet their Redeemer is strong; the Lord Almighty is his name. He will vigorously defend their cause so that he may bring rest to their land, but unrest to those who live in Babylon. Lord Jesus we receive what you have done for us, you have washed us with your blood, touched our lips with a coal and made us strong. We accept the call, we accept the responsibility, we are your people who are called by your name." Jeremiah 50:34

Prayer Points

- We, the Assemblies of God in NZ, humble ourselves and we pray. We humble ourselves and we seek your face. We turn from our wicked ways, from everything earthly, unspiritual and demonic. In your great mercy hear from heaven as we cry out on behalf of those we are sent to. Forgive our sins and restore our land. Open your eyes and ears and be attentive to every prayer we pray.
- We declare the Spirit of Wisdom from above for the leaders of our Movement and of our nation. The Holy Spirit given wisdom that is first of all pure, that is also peace loving, is gentle at all times, and willing to yield to others. A wisdom that is full of mercy and the fruit of good deeds. A wisdom that shows no favouritism and is always sincere (James 3).
- Local/ National/ Global mission:
Declare a blessing and an outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the Auckland region.
Ask God to protect and anoint Pastors Binuraj and Chris Sola and all the other pastors in that region.
Pray blessing, courage, provision and wisdom for our Exec member and leader of the Tongan ethnic group Ps Anahina and Vosailangi Sikalu.
Declare a double-portion blessing over all our Tongan churches and the release of Tongan church-planters.
Pray blessing, courage, provision and wisdom for our Indian ethnic leader Ps Binuraj.
Declare a double-portion blessing over all our Indian churches and the release of Indian church-planters.

Friday 4th September

DAY 5

"It has always been my ambition to preach the gospel where Christ was not known, so that I would not be building on someone else's foundation. Rather, as it is written: "Those who were not told about him will see, and those who have not heard will understand."” Romans 15:20-21

Prayer Points

- Lord Jesus, we ask for eyes to see our community as you do, that we would see afresh the brokenness and allow our hearts to be moved with compassion. We cry out because in our nation our communities are like sheep without a shepherd, harassed and helpless.
- Forgive us for those times we have looked the other way or even crossed the road. For when our enjoyment of being found by you has blinded us from the joy-filled strength of being the answer to our neighbours.
- Thank you Jesus for showing us what it is to be sent with love, strength and power to plant new communities of faith.
- We declare that at Conference and in the years to come the Assemblies of God movement in NZ will be known for the love we have for those that don't know you yet.
- Change our hearts: so that our love for one another would shine brighter and brighter and become irresistible to unbelievers.
- Holy Spirit we ask that a grace of humility would saturate our movement. That we would open up doors for every calling, for every gifting on every life. That they would rise up and be sent to places where a new church can grow. So that in Aotearoa NZ a harvest worthy of Jesus' sacrifice is reaped.
- Local/ National/ Global mission:
Take time to bless and pray for all the churches of other denominations close to where you live.
Ask God to give wisdom and fresh anointing for the leaders of all Christian denominations in NZ.
Pray for Heather Bourn (France), Max and Dorothy Chismon (SE Asia, NZ based).

Saturday 5th September DAY 6

“See, my servant will act wisely; he will be raised and lifted up and highly exalted. Just as there were many who were appalled at him— his appearance was so disfigured beyond that of any human being and his form marred beyond human likeness—so he will sprinkle many nations, and kings will shut their mouths because of him. For what they were not told, they will see, and what they have not heard, they will understand”
Isaiah 52:13–15

Prayer Points

Pray for Sam and Carol Soukotta (Indonesia), Rod and Lynley Talbot (Africa).

Monday 14th September DAY 15

“And the Lord turned to him and said, “Go in this might of yours and save Israel from the hand of Midian; do not I send you?” And he said to him, “Please, Lord, how can I save Israel? Behold, my clan is the weakest in Manasseh, and I am the least in my father’s house.” And the Lord said to him, “But I will be with you, and you shall strike the Midianites as one man.”
Judges 6:14–16

Prayer Points

- We say of our God that He is the strength and shield of the Assemblies of God in NZ. That it is the Lord of the Harvest who watches over us night and day to lead and guide as we more than double our influence and footprint before 2033.
- Local/ National/ Global mission:
Declare a blessing and an outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the Waikato.
Ask God to protect and anoint Ps Liz Brandon and the other pastors in that region.

Sunday 13th September

DAY 14

"But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light. Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy." 1 Peter 2:9-10

Prayer Points

- Be led by the Holy Spirit and take these words from 1 Pet 2 (below) and repeat them as a declaration over individuals, towns, churches and nations... Insert the names of people, your town/ city, your church and nations etc, into the brackets [] as you are led.
...For you [] are a chosen people. You [] are royal priests, a holy nation, God's very own possession. As a result, you [] can show others the goodness of God, for he called you [] out of the darkness into his wonderful light and has sent you to do great exploits in his mighty name.
- Local/ National/ Global mission:
Declare a blessing and an outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the Bay of Plenty.
Ask God to protect and anoint Ps Dennis and Mina Acraman and the other pastors in that region.
Pray blessing, courage, provision and wisdom for our Exec member Ps Joseph and Lisa McAuley
Pray for the peace of Jerusalem and for revival in Israel. That Jesus would be embraced as the Messiah and celebrated as the fulfilment of the ancient promises to the Jewish people.

Sunday 6th September

DAY 7

*"But thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. Therefore, my dear brothers and sisters, stand firm. Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labour in the Lord is not in vain."
1 Corinthians 15:57-58*

Prayer Points

- Heavenly Father I honour you for being the God who never stops working, for being the God who is always on mission. That the relentless pursuit of lost people is your passion and your core business. Father I rejoice that I am your child and I share this mission DNA with you. Today Father I dedicate myself afresh to the job you have given me to do in your business.
