





2025 At A Glance Report

2025 was one of Musicians Foundation’s most impactful years ever, as 238 grants were given to musicians throughout the country. Those impacted by the Los Angeles-area wildfires received grants via the Foundation’s Disaster Aid Program at the beginning of the year, and the traditional grant program remained an important safety net as it has since 1914. Nearly \$150,000 was granted to support musicians’ housing costs, medical and dental bills, utilities, and more. Grants in the traditional program generally ranged from \$1,000 to \$2,500.

- Our average grantee had **26 years of professional experience**.
 - The average grantee age was **51 years old**.
- **87%** of grantees **had health insurance** (up 8% from 2023).
 - Grants sent to musicians in **16 different states**.
