Scholarships in memory of Ricky & funding for the Ricky Woodring Memorial Events Plaza

- ▶ The Heart of Gold Baseball Scholarship awarded for work ethics and sportsmanship, a Memorial Music Scholarship, a Special Education Resource Scholarship, and the Reno Continental Baseball Scholarship for players who need financial assistance. 34% of tournament profits supports these scholarships.

Galena High School Athletics | Ricky Woodring Memorial Events Plaza

- ▶ Funding towards the Ricky Woodring Memorial Event Plaza, which will provide Galena High School students and other various age groups in the community the opportunity to hold tournaments and clinics for all sports.
- ▶ 33% of tournament profits are designated for the building of the Ricky Woodring Events Plaza. All the underground work, sewer, electrical, and water has been completed. Permits for the building have been approved. To date, we have raised \$170,000. Due to the rising cost of construction, we are trying to reach our goal of \$250,000 within a year, so the prices don't keep increasing for the project.

Galena High School Baseball Program

- ▶ 33% of tournament profits will be used toward uniform and tournament expenses during the baseball season including necessary field maintenance/renovations needed.

Scholarships & many kind donations are a tribute to Ricky

Ricky was 17 years old and a senior at Galena High School. While on his way home from off-campus baseball practice, Ricky lost his life in an automobile accident. He was a talented baseball pitcher (#35) who planned on playing college baseball. Ricky was also a gifted guitar and piano player with dreams of going to Julliard. Ricky achieved academic success after receiving help with ADD and said he would like to help people like himself one day.

Scholarships in his memory benefit athletics, special education and music. Since Ricky's passing, The Ricky Woodring/Galena High Golf Tournaments, the Ricky Woodring Memorial Concerts and many kind donations, have provided:

\$14,300 to Reno Continental/South Reno Babe Ruth

Financial scholarships help pay for season fees, cleats and gloves for young men whose families are in need.

\$50,250 to Galena High School Scholarships

This includes the Ricky Woodring "Heart of Gold" Baseball Scholarship awarded for work ethics and sportsmanship, the Ricky Woodring Memorial Music Scholarship & the Ricky Woodring Resource Scholarship which is awarded to a student with well-rounded achievements including academic, in spite of a health impairment or a learning disability.

\$45,489 to Galena Athletic Programs

This includes help with uniforms, games and tournament costs for all athletic programs.

\$121,961 to Galena High School Baseball Program

Ricky was planning a fundraising program for the baseball program at the time of his accident. He was committed to helping the program.

\$170,000 to Galena Event Plaza

The next phase will be excavation and building the structure which will house the ticket booths, restrooms, food and concession stands along with storage.

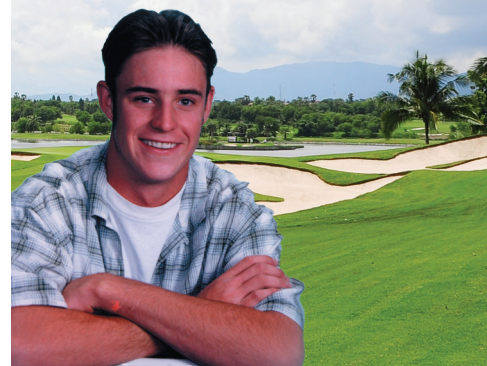
