



Financial Support for International Students

We aim for your time at HID to be rewarding and enjoyable. This information guide has been produced to provide you with all of the information you require on financial support for international students during your studies at HID. Please read this information carefully, and contact us should you require further information. Applicants to HID should email hidadmissions@holmeseducation.group. Current students studying at HID should email hello@hid.ie.

Students are expected to be able to cover the full cost of tuition, compulsory costs and all living expenses whilst studying at HID. Of course we understand that unexpected events can occur which may result in financial hardship to you. HID has a limited fund available to assist students in this situation.

Tuition Scholarships

HID offers generous tuition fee scholarships to students, awarded on the basis of academic merit or financial need. Any scholarship awarded to you is clearly listed on your offer letter, and applies to the duration of your programme (subject to satisfactory academic performance).

Payment Plans

Where students are facing difficulties in payment of continuing tuition fees by the advertised deadline, at our discretion we may offer a payment plan to assist you in staggering the cost of tuition. Payment plans are agreed on an individual basis and can be requested by emailing hello@hid.ie.

Fee Waivers

In addition to your tuition fees, there are other fees which may become due whilst you are studying with us, for example payment of resit or repeat fees. If you are suffering genuine financial hardship in paying for these additional fees, please contact us as soon as possible at hello@hid.ie – in some cases we may be able to waive additional fees depending on your circumstances.

Emergency Hardship

Please note that HID is unable to offer cash advances, loans or grants to students except in very limited circumstances where the safety of a student is at risk. Students who are experiencing financial difficulties are encouraged to contact the institute at the earliest opportunity to discuss your situation confidentially with a member of staff.

Tax Relief

Any programme undertaken at Holmes Institute Dublin is approved for tax relief for eligible students at the standard rate of income tax. The person who has paid the fees may claim the relief. The maximum amount of income tax relief you can claim is €7,000 per course, per person, per academic year. Each claim is subject to a single disregard amount of €3,000 (FT) or €1,500 (PT) each tax year. Further information on income tax relief can be found [here](#).
