



CAMPING RULES 2026



By reserving your campsite, you agree to the following:

1. All campers are required to purchase event tickets. Campsites can only be purchased by those that have a weekend pass. All campground occupants must always wear their event wristband once exchanged for their ticket. **Lose, tamper with or have your wristband removed by security or OPP and you must purchase a new ticket.** If you have a problem with your wristband, report directly to the Will Call/Ticket booth.
2. Each campsite is made for 1 (one) vehicle and 1 (one) camping unit (trailer) - one steering wheel per site. If you wish to add a tent, that is allowed but you **MUST** remain within the boundary of your campsite. Trailers or tents are allowed on any site, with the exception of Tent City, which is for tents **ONLY**.
3. Price for camping is per site, not per person and for the entire weekend Wednesday through to Sunday, inclusive.
4. Campsite and layout subject to change without notice or compensation.
5. **All vehicles, towed trailers and campers MUST be licensed, plated and road legal. No homemade livestock, utility trailers or boats allowed. Modified trailers must have proper ventilation, windows and emergency exits. All doors must be able to open from both the inside and the outside. All trailers must have working smoke and CO detectors and liquid propane alarms (if applicable). Any trailers deemed unfit can be refused entry into the festival grounds at the discretion of LMITF, Security or OPP without compensation to the ticket holder.**
6. Camping is for all ages, however **only those 19+ are permitted to purchase a campsite and are to remain on site all weekend.** . Any campsites found not to have someone 19+ camping at that site will be refused entry or result in eviction without compensation.
7. Re-entry of vehicles is allowed during posted times and through GATE 1 (Washington St.). **All vehicles re-entering camping MUST have a sticker AFFIXED** to their windshield. Exit via Gate 3 (Walter St.). If/when gates are closed, overnight parking is available at "Lucknow Community Centre" (649 Campbell St.) or the Soccer fields (790 Havelock St. N).
8. **NO GLASS BOTTLES** - they will be confiscated without compensation. **ONLY** cans and plastic allowed. This applies to beer, wine, coolers, all beverage and food containers.
9. Be mindful when setting up tents and trailers to avoid windows and doors to be near any exhaust fumes including generators, vehicle exhausts and BBQ's. Always keep tent and trailer openings in well ventilated areas.
10. **NO PETS** are allowed on any of the festival grounds, including camping, with the exception being service animals with current rabies vaccination.
11. **NO OPEN FIRES ALLOWED.** This includes propane fire pits. BBQ's, grills, smokers or small cooking appliances are allowed for cooking **ONLY** - propane only. Cooking appliances are to be used under the following conditions:
 - Only use propane as the primary fuel.
 - Only one (1) cooking appliance per campsite.
 - Must bear a certification from a nationally recognized certification agency.
 - Maximum amount of propane per campsite may not exceed 30 pounds.
 - One meter (1m) of clearance must be kept around the appliance at all times.
 - Appliances may only be used from 7AM-2AM.
 - When in-use, appliances may not be left unattended.

12. Garbage/Recycling – Bagged garbage and recycling is picked up daily from campsites and new bags will be handed out. Please help our volunteers by separating your garbage, recycling and returnable alcohol containers. **MESSY CAMPSITES ARE GROUNDS FOR EVICTION.**
13. Alcohol is to be consumed on your campsite. **NO alcohol is allowed on campsite roadways or to be brought into the concert area.** Please note that this is a rule set out by the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario and beyond our control.
14. All campers are expected to be courteous to those around them. **Quiet hours are 1:00 AM to 9:00 AM** so as not to disrupt nearby campers. Failure to comply may result in eviction from the event grounds at the discretion of LMITF, security and/or OPP without compensation to the ticket holder.
15. No amplified sound systems.
16. Generators are allowed on site, but patrons may be asked to turn them off if use is loud or excessive. Generators must have a maximum 5 gallons of fuel. Battery packs are okay in tent camping. (Lucknow Fire Department reserves the right to alter any of these guidelines based on local bans and weather conditions). Be mindful of where exhaust vents to. Keep fumes away from windows and tents.
17. All vehicles and persons will be subject to search upon entering the grounds and prohibited items must be surrendered.
18. No mudding or cruising around the campsite. Once your vehicle is in, it should be parked for the weekend. Any person operating or riding in a motorized vehicle in the campgrounds or any roadway, which is not leaving or entering for the day, is subject to immediate evacuation from the event without a refund. Bicycles will be permitted in the camping areas only.
19. NO FIREWORKS, paper (floating) lanterns, incendiary devices or any type of explosive are prohibited.
20. NO personal ATV's, scooters, golf carts, e-bikes or segways etc. (personal accessibility vehicles exempt). Bicycles (non-motorized) are okay.
21. No household furniture (couches, recliners, etc.) allowed on campsites.
22. No camper or spectator shall display, broadcast or promote the following: profanity, nudity or derogatory phrases in any form including but not limited to: trailers, vehicles, flags, graffiti, music or any other visual or audio form. Failure to comply will result in immediate eviction from LMITF grounds at the discretion of OPP, Security of LMITF committee.
23. Medical/First Aid services will be available on site during the day.
24. LMITF is not responsible for lost or stolen items or damages that may occur to personal property during the festival. Please ensure all of your belongings are locked and secured when you are away from your campsite.
25. LMITF reserves the right to confiscate any items on campsites that are not permitted as outlined above, or that may be offensive to other campers.
26. **CAMPSITES MUST BE COMPLETELY CLEANED UP PRIOR TO EXIT.** Failure to comply will result in a cleanup fee of \$500.00 being charged to the on-file credit card for this campsite.
