20 Out and About

South Florida's newest art gallery opens in Delray Beach

Mixing sophisticated flare with contemporary art, the Blue Gallery, South Florida's newest gallery of contemporary art, officially opened its doors with a champagne and wine reception. Two featured artists David Schluss and Isaac Maimon, gallery owner Ramí Rotkopf and staff, many art collectors and enthusiasts, prominent civic, business and

art industry leaders, and media were present to help commemorate the night. Among the celebrants was City of Delray Beach Mayor Jeff Perlman who assisted Rotkopf in cutting the blue ribbon to commence the grand opening.

Rotkopf, who at age 15 took a one-night stint job as a doorman at a prestigious art gallery in Tel Aviv, Israel, and parlayed the experience into a

lifelong business, passion, and advocacy for some of the most well-known contemporary artists, is excited about his newest venture on the corner of Atlantic Avenue and Federal Highway. The gallery features landscapes, abstracts, semi-

realistic, realistic and figurative styles by eight contemporary artists and sculptors: Gabriella Fenyves, Lenner Gogli, Bracha Guy, Isaac Maimon, Alex Pauker, David Schluss, Calman Shemi and Ben-Simhon. Mediums include

original paintings, sculpture, serigraphs and etchings.

It was the energy and panache of Delray that drew 40-year-old Rotkopf to construct his 3,500-square-foot open loft-style gallery. He deliberately exploits the continuous panoramic floor-to-ceiling corner of glass windows to transmit the richness of texture and color of the gallery's featured works out to an audience of passersby and car traffic.

According to Rotkopf, "everyday is a new day at Blue Gallery." The uniquely designed gallery's fits and finishes incorporate unique display technologies developed in France—a sophisticated hanging swivel display system—in which art is displayed on oversized two-sided panels suspended from the ceiling that can be reversed easily from front to back to intrigue viewers. This technology enables the view from the street and from inside the gallery to change effortlessly within seconds.



This anniversary edit brings together artists we've lived with for years, plus voices that feel essential right now, each with a distinct visual language, each unmistakably their own.



Tuscan landscapes and Pixel works that glow with color, texture, and light.


