LATINOS IN THE SOUTH

In 2002, the Latino Commission on AIDS recognized that the growing Latino communities in the South frequently had no healthcare access, were not adequately reached through traditional health/prevention awareness programs, and faced numerous language barriers as many health service agencies lacked Spanish-speaking or culturally conversant employees.



In the summer of 2007, the Latino Commission on AIDS launched its strategic program initiative: Latinos in the Deep South. Latinos in the Deep South worked in seven states: North Carolina, South Carolina, Alabama, Georgia, Tennessee, Louisiana, and Mississippi. In 2019, Latinos in the Deep South became Latinos in the South, adding Texas and Florida to our target states. That same year, Latinos in the South convened the first Encuentro, a yearly Southern gathering of the multi-racial Latinx LGBTQ+ community and leaders to end the HIV epidemic.



Last year, the Encuentro was held in Charlotte, NC, and we welcomed close to 150 LGBTQ+ Latinx health advocates and allies from across the Southeast





ENCUENTRO 2025

In recent years, the Southeastern states have become home to some of the fastest-growing destinations for Latinxs. As a result of this rapid growth, the Deep South states have had slow responses to the needs and barriers of treating, caring for, and providing adequate and quality services for the Latinx community. The South has consistently reported the highest rates of HIV diagnosis of any US region (AL, FL, GA, LA, MS, TN, SC, and TX). Access to HIV-related medical care is complicated by fear, stigma, and, for undocumented immigrants, a variety of administrative, practical, and legal obstacles. The South is also home to the highest percentage of LGBTQ+ community members and also experiences a record number of anti-LGBTQ+ legislation impacting the well-being and health of our communities.

Approximately 100 participants will gather in Atlanta, GA, to address the challenges above, increase their organizational development and leadership capacity, establish a collective vision for advocacy in the South, and develop their own stories with a focus on race, ethnicity, sexuality, and gender identity. Interpretation is provided wholly throughout the conference as part of our commitment to language justice. Participants are encouraged to submit abstracts, and for many, it is their first time presenting at a conference regarding their work in the South without the limitation of language.
