



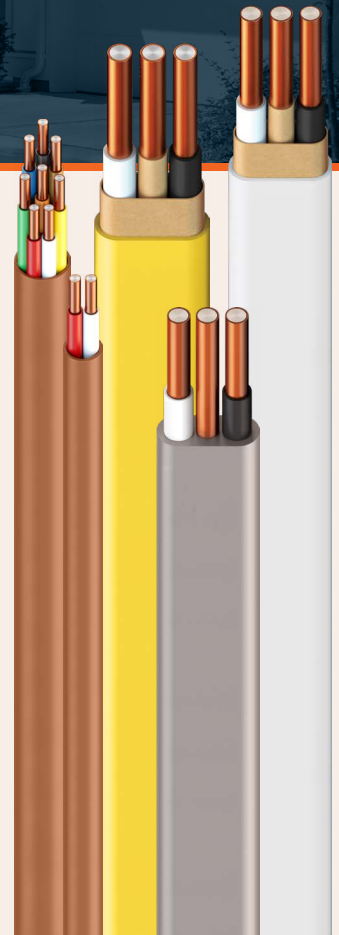

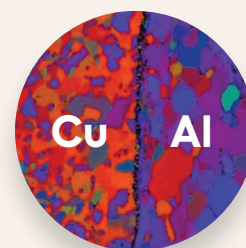

Copperweld® Copper-Clad Aluminum (CCA) Building Wire combines an AA-8000 Series aluminum core with an oxygen-free copper exterior, permanently joined through a metallurgical bond. The result puts each material to work where its properties provide the greatest advantage — creating a purpose-engineered alternative to the conventional all-copper approach.



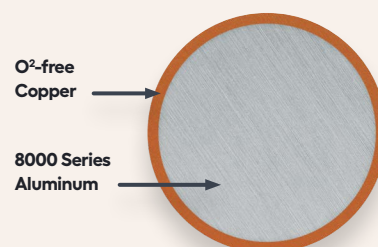
Purpose-Engineered Construction

Copperweld® Copper-Clad Aluminum (CCA) places copper across 100% of the conductor surface, while an AA-8000 Series aluminum alloy forms the core. Copperweld's proprietary cladding process creates a permanent metallurgical bond between the two metals, producing a unified bimetallic conductor engineered to ASTM B566.



The Right Material in the Right Place

Copper provides the exterior surface and connection interface where its properties provide the greatest advantage, while aluminum at the core reduces reliance on copper and provides important material advantages. The result is a conductor that uses approximately one-sixth the copper of an equivalently rated copper conductor.

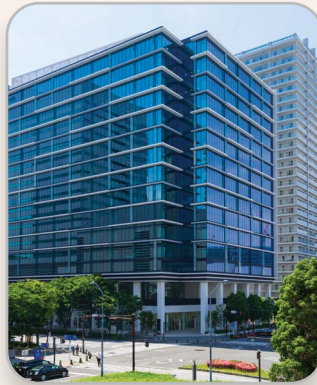
