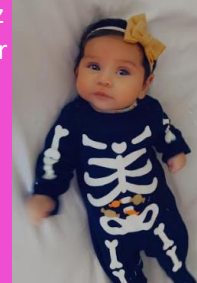

Reducing food safety hazards

- **Glass/Hard Plastic policy** – minimizing and controlling the possible contamination through glass and hard plastic particles
- **Pest Control** – control and elimination of unwanted pest, rodents and insects
- **GMP's** – keeping the warehouse areas clean and well organized to minimize cross contamination
- **Personal Hygiene** – minimizing the impact of bacteria and keeping employees safe
- **Chemicals/Cleaners policy** – minimizing the possible contamination by controlling the type and amount of used chemicals
