

Our new sports court is progressing in time for the nicer weather.


We currently have the concrete completed and the court has been installed for the final steps.

Today the Client Committee assisted with the donations to Oz Harvest with loading the truck and who could refuse a photo opportunity.




BIRTHDAYS THIS MONTH


