

About the Conference

Grounded in the success of PAC's (Patchogue Arts Council) PEACE (Partners in Education, Arts, & Community Empowerment) Project, this gathering highlights powerful collaborations that advance equity, deepen student engagement, and strengthen community connections. The program is designed to share practical classroom strategies alongside the policies and partnerships that sustain long-term impact.

This year's conference features a keynote address by internationally acclaimed artist and activist Edel Rodríguez, whose bold visual work—rooted in themes of migration, identity, and social justice—has shaped global conversations across art, media, and public life. His keynote will inspire attendees to consider how creative expression can confront urgent issues, elevate student voice, and spark meaningful change.
