

For 27 years, SEF, USA has been relentlessly working to help eliminate curable blindness in India by providing FREE eye surgeries to those in need through a network of 29 hospitals in 14 states in India. SEF, USA is the world's largest free eye care program.

Rural outreach program

SEF, USA takes eye care to the doorsteps of rural India. This is done by conducting eye camps in villages, identifying patients needing surgery, transporting them to the nearest network hospital, providing free eye surgeries, and transporting them back to their homes.

Patients become economically independent and regain their dignity. Young women trained as Vision Care Technicians also find employment and independence.

Rescuing the future


