India's Blindness Challenge

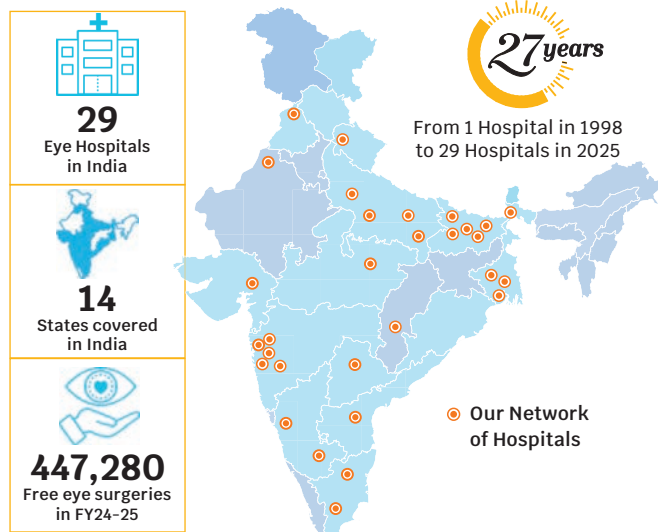
- The world's largest blind population lives in India.

SEF, USA, was founded in 1998 in San Jose, CA, supporting one hospital in Coimbatore, India, performing 8,000 free eye surgeries annually.

Currently, SEF, USA supports a network of 29 hospitals across 14 states in India, performing over 447,280 free eye surgeries annually. Today, it is the world's largest free eye care program!

For 27 years, SEF, USA has been working relentlessly to eliminate curable blindness by providing FREE eye surgeries to those who need it.

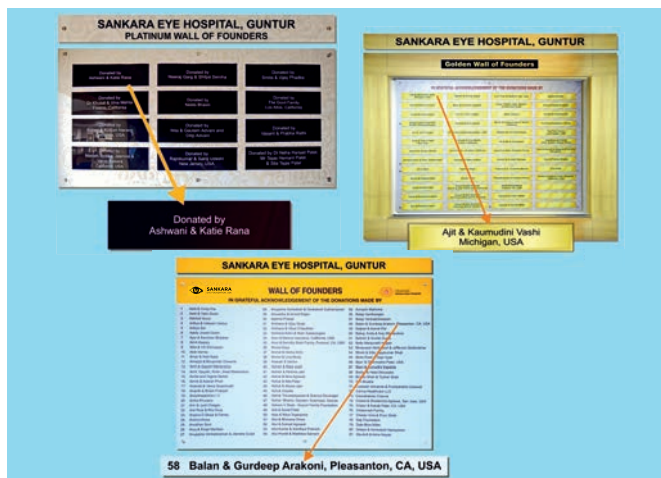

Rural Outreach Program

SEF, USA delivers free quality eye care to the underserved rural communities in India.

Through eye camps, patients needing treatment are identified and transported to the nearest SEF Hospital where they are given free surgery, care, lodging and meals for two days and returned safely back to their villages. Follow up visit by medical teams ensures full recovery.

Our hospitals recruit and train local women from economically disadvantaged families as paramedics and hospital staff, empowering not just a few, but generations of women.

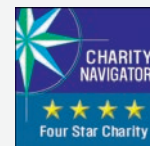
