Many congratulations on securing a place at Oxford and The Queen's College. We are very much looking forward to meeting you in October. I am sure that you will find the College a friendly and supportive place for learning and study.

This letter concerns the formal arrangements for you to become a member of the College. It is important that you read it carefully and follow the instructions.

You are personally liable to pay the course fee of £9,250 but you may receive assistance from a Student Funding Agency (e.g. Student Finance England) by way of a grant or a tuition fee loan from the Student Loan Company. You should have already returned your financial guarantee form, with your student funding confirmation letter if applicable, but if you have not then you must do so immediately. If you have indicated that you are self-funding, you will be invoiced for your full first year's fees when you arrive at College and will be expected to pay these at the latest by 3.00 p.m. on Friday of the 4th Week of Michaelmas Term (8th November 2024).

All new students, regardless of funding source, also receive a bill (which we call 'batells') when they first arrive in College. This will be for the room charge for Michaelmas Term 2024 (f,1,622). It is also payable by the deadline of **8**th **November 2024**.

We ask that you return two completed forms to us, with one passport-sized colour photograph:

- 1. The **University Card form** (enclosed), which you must complete and return in order to become a member of the University. Please attach a **passport-sized colour photograph** to the form. This photograph will be used for your University Card.
- 2. The **College Record Form**. By completing the College Record Form <u>here</u>, you are confirming that you have read, understood, and agree to the College's policies as detailed in the form.

Please sign and return your University Card Form electronically, to freshers.forms@queens.ox.ac.uk and also complete the online College Record Form no later than 9th September 2024.
