We will have fun.



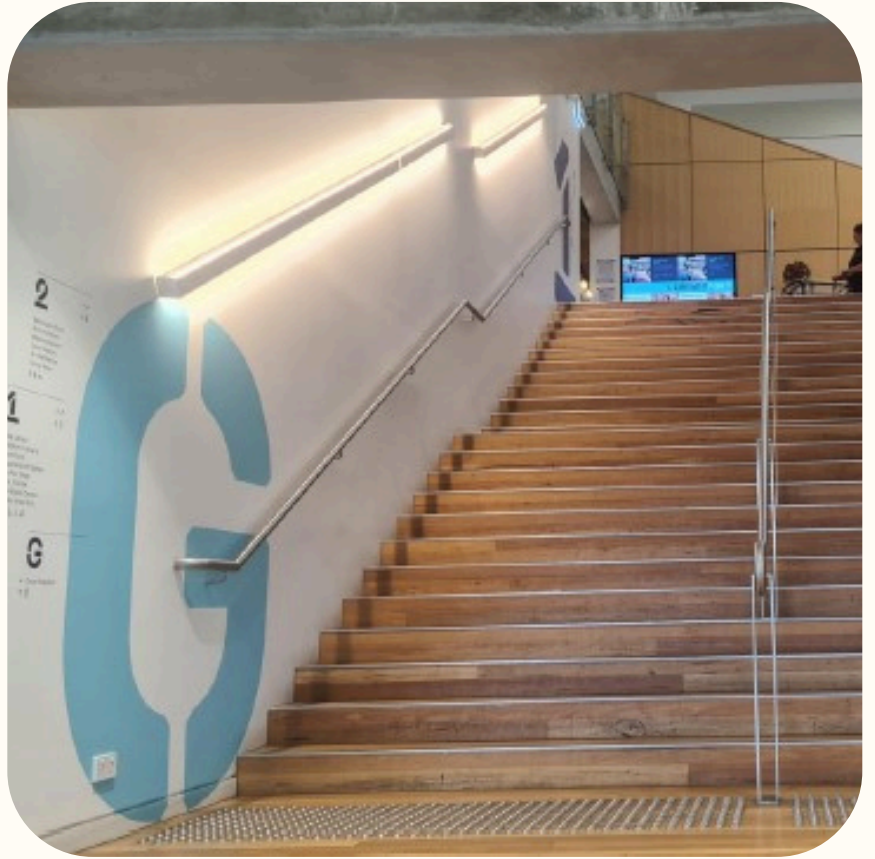


We will walk in the ground floor entrance through the sliding glass doors and sit and wait on the bottom of the BIG stairs.

When we are inside the Gallery we make sure we ...

and only look at artworks. We are not allowed to touch them.

This is how we make sure the artworks are kept safe.





We make sure we stay close to our tour guide, they tell me lots of interesting things about the artworks.

They ask us about the artwork, we put up our hand to share what we can see.

We learn about artists and how artworks have been made.
