

### Your Task at Hand

As a volunteer, you will have the opportunity to work with a small set of Students under the guidance of a Fellow Mentor. You will be responsible for mentoring your Students, teaching them a subject or a skill, and improving learning outcomes.

As you volunteer with us, we hope to immerse you in experiences that will help to develop a better understanding of yourself, others in your community, and education in India.

#### Hence, your two main objectives as a volunteer at Teach For India would be to -



Facilitate learning for a small group of Students and help combat the education crisis



Immerse yourself in experiences to understand yourself, others in your community, and education in India



### Time Commitment



This time investment is inclusive of both objectives - teaching Students as well as grow your understanding of education equity.

Volunteers are expected to complete their fifty hours over the course of three to four months, if not earlier.

Volunteers are awarded a certificate once they complete the minimum requirement of 50 hours.

### Mode of Volunteering

In the context of our Students - from little to no access to technology, network, and unsafe learning environments at home, the physical space of a school is of utmost importance to their learning and development needs.

Hence, **most of our volunteer opportunities are offline** spread across our eight cities (Delhi, Pune, Mumbai, Bengaluru, Hyderabad, Chennai, Ahmedabad, Kolkata).

For applicants beyond these eight cities, you may apply for the limited opportunities we have in online volunteering - number of opportunities can be checked at the application stage.



Most opportunities are offline,

Volunteers are required to travel to school and teach Students



Very limited online opportunities,

Volunteers can teach Students using an online collaboration tool such as Google Meet or Zoom

#### Distance and Travel

Keeping in mind that travel to an assigned school can be difficult, we have divided our cities into clusters, and request applicants to select three preferences for placements. You will be assigned a school only in your preferences.

Choose three clusters in your city you can travel to.



You will be assigned a classroom in only these clusters.

### Teaching on Zoom

If allotted an online opportunity, volunteers prepare material to teach Students via an online collaboration tool. They prepare content more suitable to the online scenario.

Additionally, they coordinate with their Students to join on time, update them regularly by leveraging digital forms of communications, and follow up if they're unable to join on time.

As you step into the volunteering program, we have designed a set of trainings for you. These have been created to introduce you to different aspects of the program.






We will introduce you to Teach For India's mission and vision as well as help you to understand your role in our classrooms.

We will familiarize you with policies that govern our work and the expected code of conduct before you enter schools.




Part III - Working with kids

Applicants to the program choose two preferences from the following list, and are given an opportunity to teach one of them depending on availability in our classrooms.




### Planning for content and teaching.

It is undisputed that it takes effective and purposeful planning for each and every class to guarantee student learning and takeaways. Hence, it is imperative that our volunteers have a simple yet basic idea of what they are going to teach documented before entering a session with students. Worry not! We will take you through a basic template during your onboarding.

In certain cases, volunteers may be requested to reschedule their sessions if they are not able to plan before starting.


Weekday Morning(7:00AM - 12:00PM)
