CHE COSA SONO I VINI ARANCIONI?

Vini arancioni aka ‘orange wines’ are essentially white wines that are made more like reds. This means the juice is left in contact with the grape skins (prolonged maceration) which extracts phenolics (flavour compounds), colour, and tannic structure. These wines are treated more oxidatively than your average white wine, and some are fermented and/or aged in large clay vessels or wood barrels. The resulting colour of the wine can range from pale coppery-gold to deep orange or tawny brown.

- 2022 ‘Inti’ Garganega Verona IGT, Corte Sant’Alda, Veneto.....86
From biodynamic calcareous limestone vineyards just outside Verona. INTI, for the Incas is the God of the Sun and “the generator of life”. Scents of wild honey, peach tea, menthol and mandarin essence. The palate is bold and slightly spicy — 12%
- 2020 Pinot Grigio Riserva Collio DOC, Primosic, Friuli-Venezia Giulia.....90
Don’t be fooled by the term “Pinot Grigio”. This isn’t your Auntie’s insipid industrial tonsil wash complete with ice cubes. 6-7 days of skin contact. Intense amber red with aromas of violets and stewed fruit. Powerful and complex on the palate with a rich and mineral finish — 14%
- 2020 ‘Barricato Bianco’, Toscana IGT, Fattoria La Violla, Toscana 95
From a biodynamic estate that has turned their family farm into an intensive source of local employment. A stunning array of peach, candied ginger and resinous notes. The wine is cloudy and unfiltered but you don’t need to be a filthy hippie to enjoy sucking this back like fruit juice — 13%
- 2016 ‘Ribolla Gialla Riserva’ Collio DOC, Primosic, Friuli-Venezia Giulia 113
Hand harvested Ribolla Gialla grapes fermented naturally and matured in barrels on the lees for twelve months.’Scents of yellow plum, marjoram and chestnut. Gorgeous and robust mouthfeel with apricot, beeswax and mineral flavours. A great introduction to orange wine — 13.5%

Violet, kirsch, leather, graphite and cola on the nose. The palate is slightly sanguine with rooibos, fennel seed, cured meat and peppercorn nuances over chewy tannins — 13.5%
- 2019 ‘Daginestra’ Aglianico del Vulture Superiore DOCG, Grifalco, Basilicata..... 119
60-80 year old vines on volcanic soil. Dense crimson with aromas of black cherry, smoke, wild rose and fern. Mineral-driven palate with crushed raspberry, charred meat and mint leaf framed with a velvety brush of tannin — 13.5%

100% organic blend of Gaglioppo with a bit of Magliocco this vintage. Medium ruby with scents of licorice, wood spice and mineral. The palate has bing cherry, tea leaf, molten metal and a slightly rustic brush of tannin — 13.5%
