PEAK **Winter** League is offered to provide a first-class opportunity for boys and girls “B” level feeder teams and select teams. Our FALL & Spring PEAK Leagues are open to all the select and AAU talent of teams, but the PEAK Winter League is not a suitable fit for ETL players or top level AAU teams.

LEAGUE SPORTSMANSHIP STANDARDS

Participants

- (1) Must respect the administrators, officials and opponents at all times.
- (2) No profanity.

Fans/Spectators

- (A) Must stay off the playing floor at all times.
- (B) Any person who enters the playing floor, uses obscene gestures or language, and/or is any way disruptive to the spirit of the contest shall be asked to leave the gymnasium.
- (C) It shall be the responsibility of the Program Director/Coach to monitor the behavior of their parents/fans and intercede when they are behaving inappropriately.

General League Policies

Team Rosters

- (A) All team rosters are due before the first game. All players must have a number on their uniform.
- (B) All team rosters (including player jersey numbers) are “frozen” after the first game.
- (C) Players cannot play on more than one roster per division.
- (D) Maximum roster size shall not exceed 14 players.
- (E) Players must participate in a minimum of 7 games to play in the end of season tournament.
- (F) Participation of a non-rostered player in a game will result in a forfeiture of that game and possible disqualification from postseason tournament.
- (G) AAU teams or any team not deemed a school feeder team will be required to play up a division.

Due Process

- (A) Any organization and/or procedural disputes/concerns not covered in the “Game Rules” will be remedied by the League Director(s).
- (B) All decisions are final.

GAME RULES

SECTION 1: GOVERNING BODY & GENERAL INFORMATION

- (A) All play will be governed by the rules established by the National Federation of State High School Associations with the following exceptions:
 - a. There will be no shot clock at any division.
 - b. 4th Grade Division: Teams can only play man-to-man defense.
 - c. 4th Grade Division: Double teams are only allowed inside the 3-point arc.
- (B) Game balls will be provided by the home team (wearing white). Each team should provide their own warmup balls.
- (C) No locker room facilities are available.

SECTION 2: TIME

- (A) All games will consist of two (2) twenty (20) minute halves.
 - a. Running time will occur during the first eighteen (18) minutes of each half. Regular stop clock time will occur during the last two (2) minutes of each half.
 - i. No stop clock or press with a 20 point lead.
 - b. Halftime will be three (3) minutes.
 - c. Five (5) minutes will be allowed between all games.
- (B) Overtime
 - a. First overtime: Two (2) minutes stopped clock.
 - b. Second overtime: One (1) minute stopped clock.
 - c. Third overtime: First team to score two (2) or more points.
- (C) Timeouts
 - a. Each team receives two (2) time outs per half.
 - b. Timeouts do not carry over from the first half to second half nor from the second half to overtime.
 - c. Each team will be allowed one (1) timeout during each overtime period.
- (D) Game Forfeit
 - a. Occurs if a team has fewer than (5) players to start a game.
 - b. Teams are given a grace period of five minutes to field five players. Five minutes is counted from either the scheduled start of the game or five minutes after the conclusion of the previous game.
 - c. If a team forfeits a game without prior notice and a valid reason that team will not be eligible to participate in the playoffs.

SECTION 4: FOULS

- (A) A total of five (5) personal fouls will disqualify a player.
- (B) The seventh (7) team foul will result in the bonus and one-and-one free throws.
- (C) The tenth (10) team foul will result in the double bonus and two free throws.
- (D) Technical Fouls
 - a. All technical fouls are both personal and team fouls.
 - b. Technical result in two points and the ball.
 - c. Any player or coach who receives two (2) technical fouls in the same game will be ejected from that game and prohibited from coaching/playing for the rest of the day.
 - d. Two (2) ejections in the same season will result in disqualification from the league and review of the League Directors.

SECTION 5: THE PLAYOFFS

- (A) All teams make the playoffs.
- (B) Levels may be split into multiple divisions to create more equitable playoff games.
- (C) All brackets will be single elimination.
- (D) Teams will be seeded based on regular season record.
 - a. Tie-Breakers:
 - i. Winning Percentage
 - ii. Head-to-head records
 - iii. "Quality Win" – win against highest seed.
 - iv. Coin flip.
