Culling Data	 Have you used and saved 'advanced searches' to pull up responsive files? Are you producing only documents tagged as 'responsive'? Have you dealt with duplicate files?
Format	Have you confirmed a production format ? (Refer to your ESI protocol)
Load Files	If it's a load file production Have you included the right load file metadata fields? Are the DATA, TEXT, and IMAGE folders/files working properly?
Bates Numbers	☐ Are your Bates numbers sequenced and stamped appropriately?
Privacy/Redactions	 ☐ Have you redacted all privileged/sensitive information? ☐ Have you confirmed there aren't privileged documents in your production? ☐ Have you verified the confidentiality status (yes/no/mixed) of all documents?
File Families	☐ Are all file families consistently tagged?
Audit trail	 Have you prepared/updated document production logs? Have you prepared/updated privilege and/or redaction logs? Have you filled in the document audit table? (You'll find it in Step 8, here.)
Sharing	Have you decided how you're going to share your production?
