Training Content:

- Introduction: Overview of gasoline safety and the purpose of the training.
- Statistics: Information highlighting the frequency and impact of gasoline-related incidents.
- Characteristics of Gasoline: Details on the properties and behaviour of gasoline.
- WMIS and TDG: Relevant Workplace Hazardous Materials Information System and Transportation of Dangerous Goods information.
- Gasoline Characteristics and Facts: Key facts and further details about gasoline.
- Safety Hazards: Identification of potential risks associated with gasoline use and storage.
- First Aid Measures: Steps to take in the event of gasoline exposure or accidents.
- Safe Practices When Handling Gasoline: Practical guidance on how to safely manage gasoline to prevent incidents.

Course Duration: The Diesel Fuel Handling Safety Program is available in two formats: in-person sessions and an online e-learning platform. For those choosing the online option, only a computer and Internet access are needed to start learning. The e-learning format is designed for flexibility, allowing participants to progress at their own pace and offering convenience to accommodate individual schedules.
