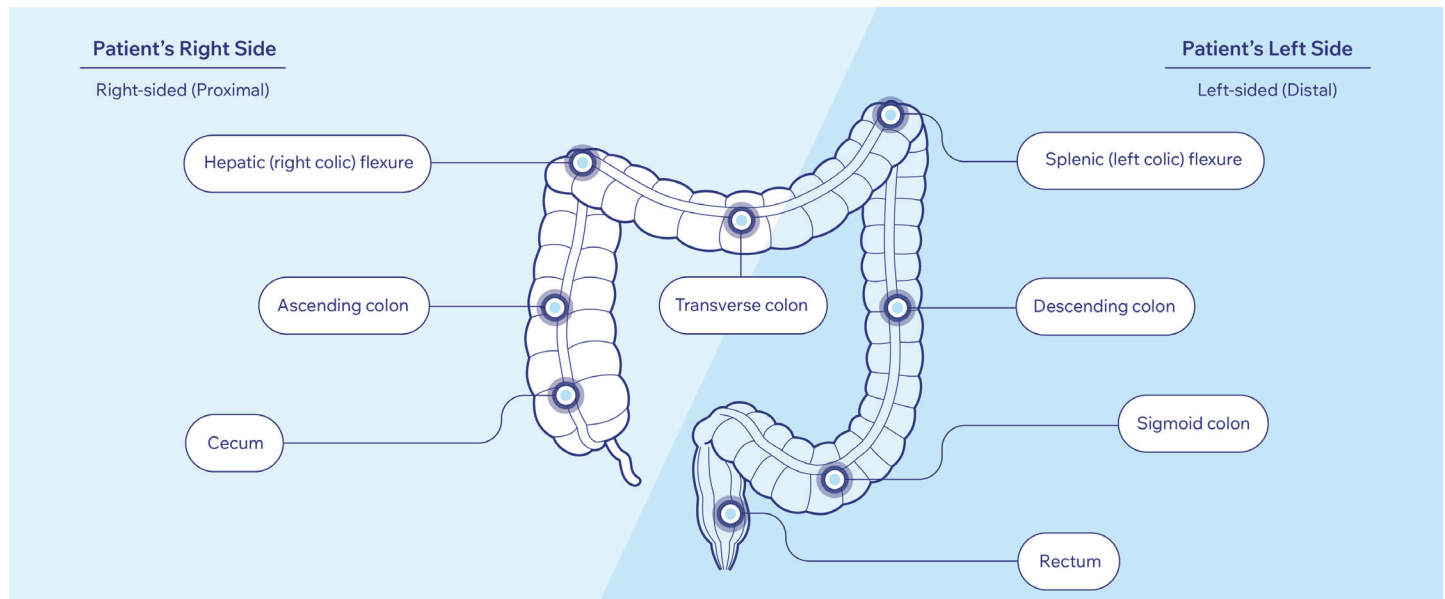




Tumor Sidedness Discussion Guide
