What are
Legal Kiosks?

Legal Kiosks are computer stations located in Georgia. They provide greater access to the civil legal system for individuals lacking adequate access to technology. At a Legal Kiosk, community members can find free legal information and forms, locate legal aid and community resources, print documents, and attend online meetings and remote court hearings.

Who can
use them?

Anyone can use a Legal Kiosk! The kiosks are designed to be a user-friendly way for residents to find legal information and resources. The kiosk interface is also screen-reader accessible.

What does a
Kiosk look like?

Kiosks are computers placed on a desk. They are located in public community spaces and sometimes may be located in rooms that have the ability to create a confidential space while the Kiosk is in use. Kiosks also come with printers and scanners.
