

Spirit of Midway

A partnership of the Midway Education Foundation & the Midway High School PTA

Purpose: The purpose of Spirit of Midway at Midway High School mirrors the mission of the school itself. That mission is to prepare each student to develop and become a mature and responsible citizen. Spirit of Midway is voluntary, non-competitive, and open to all current Midway High School students.

Requirements: to receive the Spirit of Midway Award/Patch

1. **Grades:** GPA of 80 or above
2. **Campus Involvement:** active Involvement in at least **2** Midway High School student organizations, teams or clubs
3. **Voluntary Community Service Hours**
 - ◆ 10th, 11th & 12th grade students must complete at least **20 hours** of community service hours with at least 2 different community organizations between January 1, 2025 – December 31, 2025.
 - ◆ Incoming 9th grade students must complete at least **15 hours** of community service hours with at least 2 different community organizations between June 1, 2025 - December 31, 2025.

CHANGE FOR 2025: ALL VOLUNTEER HOURS MUST BE COMPLETED WITHIN MCLENNAN COUNTY!

IMPORTANT REMINDER: Of these volunteer community service hours, no more than 5 hours may be counted for school-related service non-profits such as any Midway ISD PTA, Booster Clubs or Education Foundation. Additionally, no more than 5 hours at religious institutions may count. For example, if you volunteer and document 8 hours worked at an Elementary School carnival and 13 hours worked at your church VBS, ONLY 5 hours from the carnival and 5 hours from your church VBS will count toward this award. In this case, at least 10 hours of volunteer community service MUST be completed for 1 or more charitable, non-profit 501(c)(3) organizations outside of your church and school. (some examples of non-profit organizations are listed on page 5 of this packet.) **Please email spiritofmidway@gmail.com if you have any questions about volunteer hours, non-profit organizations or other Spirit of Midway requirement.**

Stipulations/Exclusions:

- All service must be voluntary, without pay, personal gain or the repayment of debt.
- Court ordered community service is specifically excluded.
- Community Service must be performed outside of school hours and cannot be part of a class requirement, for-profit business, place of employment or part of your MHS student organization, team, or club.
- Students will not receive Spirit of Midway credit for hours working for a private individual.

- The Spirit of Midway committee reserves the right to disqualify any submitted hours that do not meet these stipulations or others stated in this application. Additional hours may be submitted with the application in the event that other submitted hours do not qualify. When in doubt – email with questions before submitting applications!
