Inmate Transports and Courtroom Security

Inmate Transports and Courtroom Security is a scenario-based training course for correctional officers responsible for transporting inmates outside secure facilities. The course addresses the tactical, legal, and administrative challenges of maintaining the chain of custody in uncontrolled environments, such as courthouses and hospital settings, where traditional institutional security measures are absent.

Inmate transport is the weakest link in custody operations. Once an officer leaves the secure perimeter of a jail or prison, they must independently recreate security through awareness, positioning, restraint application, documentation, and decision-making. This course emphasizes that transport operations are not routine tasks but high-risk assignments that require deliberate planning and professional judgment.

Who Should Attend: This course is designed for correctional officers assigned to, or expected to be assigned to, inmate transport duties for court appearances, medical appointments, or hospital stays. It is also appropriate for line officers, transport team members, court or hospital security officers, and supervisors who oversee or support transport operations. The course is especially beneficial for personnel seeking a clearer understanding of the risks, decision-making challenges, and liability considerations associated with maintaining custody outside a secure facility.
