



The AdaptAir™ utilises Hygroflex® - a hybrid comfort foam - merging the luxurious adaptability of memory foam with the support of high-resilience foam.

By redistributing pressure and maintaining the ideal balance of moisture and temperature; it enhances the sleep climate for healthier, more restful sleep.



Pressure Redistribution

Hygroflex provides luxury envelopment with the optimal sinking experience. In mattress comfort layers, Hygroflex excels at embracing unique body contours, alleviating discomfort from pressure points and promoting a well rested sleep.



Heat Dissipation

Heat retention during sleep leads to disruptions and low sleep quality. Hygroflex is designed to significantly reduce these issues with its highly porous composition. Being up to 72% more porous than latex, Hygroflex promotes optimal airflow and sustains a refreshing, cool sleep throughout the night.



Low Hysteresis

Hysteresis loss refers to the difference in energy between the loading and unloading phase. Hygroflex features a low hysteresis, which is linked to higher comfort levels and improved sleep efficiency.



Low Friction

Foam with reduced friction offers a luxurious, comfortable sleep experience by promoting effortless movement, allowing sleepers to enjoy a deeper rest. Completing a full rotation on Hygroflex requires less than half of the force that is required on conventional memory foams.

Typical use: The 'Full - Air' system is typically prescribed for clients at higher risk of developing pressure ulcers, and is often used in the management of existing pressure injuries

The 'Full - Air' Alternating Overlay Mattress System features:

- 18 5-inch air cells running the full length of the mattress surface
- operating in a 1-in-2 cell cycle to promote consistent on-loading and tissue reperfusion
- A quiet yet powerful smart pump that delivers reliable, uninterrupted air therapy with calibration settings tailored to the user's weight and anthropometric profile
- Adjustable immersion and envelopment settings to further optimise pressure redistribution and overall patient comfort
- A digital interface - accessible via wifi or bluetooth supports real-time monitoring and pressure data reporting to help prevent under-pressurisation and reduce the risk of sacral bottoming out
- In the event of power loss, an integrated support layer maintains patient protection
- Firm sidewalls enhance edge stability to support safer transfers for both users and caregivers


Typical use: Hybrid mattresses, such as the "Hybrid - Air" Mattress, are suitable for clients with varying levels of pressure ulcer risk, including those with existing pressure injuries

The 'Hybrid - Air' mattress system features:

- Combining air cells with foam comfort layering, using both envelopment and air cell pressure to support comfort and pressure care
- Like most hybrid designs, this mattress enhances ease of transfer and manoeuvrability - offering key advantages over more clinically intensive full air alternating air systems
- Incorporating 8 alternating air cells beneath the foam layers, this provides a moderate level of active therapy
- For targeted off-loading, our detachable cell system allows targeting towards high-risk areas such as the heel section
- Firm sidewalls enhance edge stability to support safer transfers for both users and caregivers
- A quiet yet powerful smart pump that delivers reliable, uninterrupted air therapy with calibration settings tailored to the user's weight and anthropometric profile





Typical use: Our hybrid mattresses such as the 'Full - Air Comfort' are suited for clients with varying levels of pressure ulcer risk, including those with existing pressure injuries.

The hybrid 'Full - Air Comfort' mattress system is designed to integrate with:

- alternating air cells based beneath a foam comfort layer, offering both envelopment and moderate active pressure redistribution
- Relies on a combination effect of foam stability with air cell inflation to meet a range of pressure care needs while maintaining patient comfort
- In comparison to more clinically intensive full alternating air systems, hybrid systems such as the Full Air Comfort offer improved in-bed manoeuvrability and safer patient bed transfers
- Beneath the upper layer, the system features 18 5-inch air cells running the full length of the surface, delivering a consistent 1-in-2 cell therapy cycle
- For targeted offloading, this hybrid mattress includes independently detachable cells - particularly beneficial to high-risk areas such as the heels and sacral region. While powered hybrid systems provide active pressure relief, their therapeutic intensity is generally considered lower than that of the full alternating air mattress systems








Typical use: The "Full Foam" Mattress is ideal for clients at low risk of pressure ulcers, offering comfortable support for those who do not require more advanced pressure relieving systems.

The 'Full Foam' System provides:

- A transition from a standard mattress to a pressure-relieving alternating air mattress system that can provide an ideal intermediate solution
- Combining pressure-relieving Hygroflex with supportive foam comfort layers with a soft-breathable bamboo cover
- Effective pressure relief while ensuring easy manoeuvrability and safe bed entry/exit
- Designed to replicate the comfort and feel of hybrid-style mattress systems, facilitating a smoother transition for users moving from standard mattresses to more specialised options


