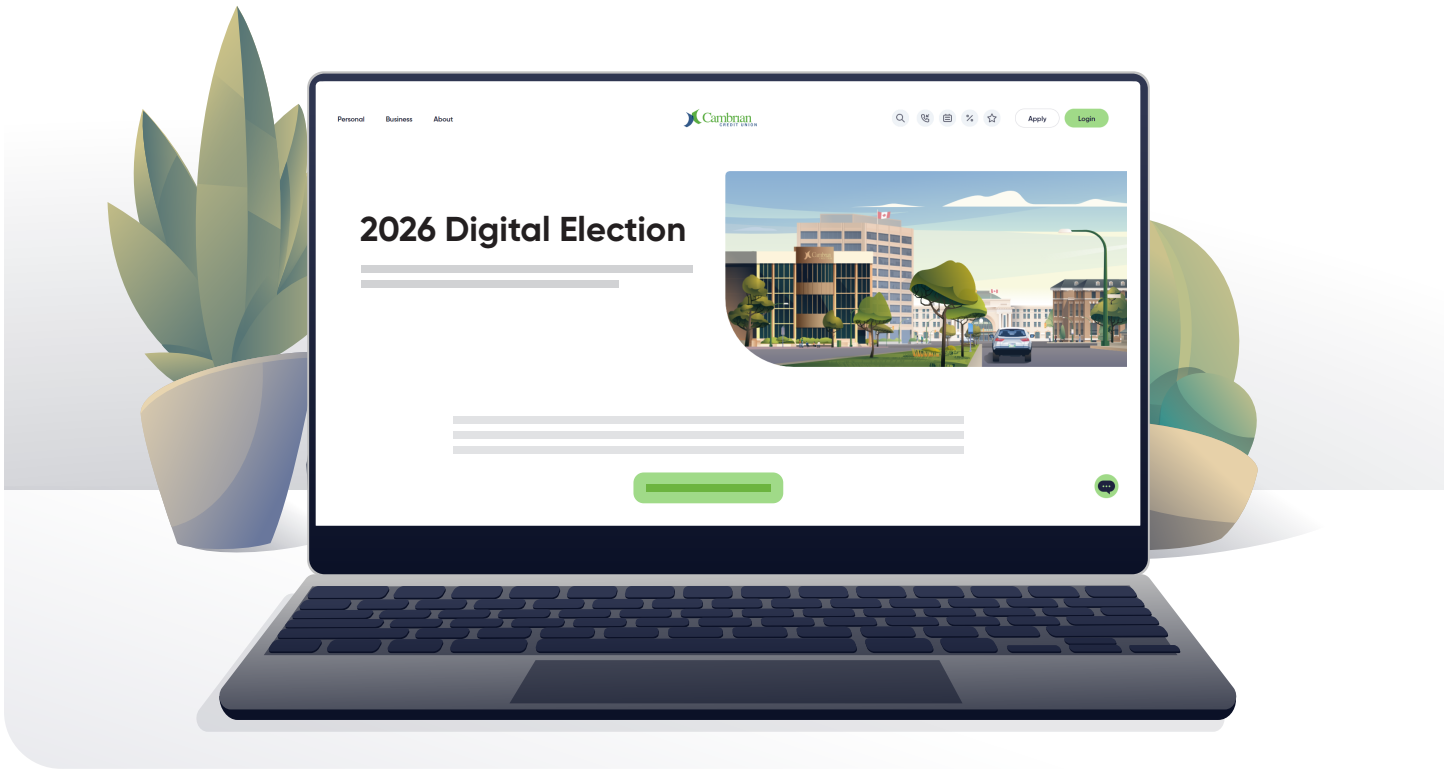


How to Vote in Cambrian's 2026 Election of Directors



This year, Cambrian is continuing to improve our **digital voting process** by introducing the ability to vote directly through online banking or our mobile app, beginning March 9.

If you don't have access to online banking or our mobile app, you can still vote from Cambrian's website using your smartphone, computer, or tablet. You can also vote by calling in via telephone.

When voting opens on **March 9**, you will receive an email or letter containing your ballot number and password. Digital voting is **quick, simple and secure**.

Who can vote?

To be eligible to vote, you must be:

- A member of Cambrian Credit Union or customer of Achieva Financial.
- 18 years of age or older.

When to vote

Voting will be open from

**Monday, March 9 to
Friday, March 27, 2026.**

How to vote



Through online banking or the mobile app

(for individual members only)

1. When voting opens on March 9, **log into your online banking account** on the full website or using the mobile app.
2. Follow the link in the pop-up window. The link will take you directly to the election website. No ballot number or password needs to be entered.
3. Read the candidate statements.
4. Follow the instructions and vote for up to three candidates.



Online, using a smartphone, computer, or tablet

(for individual members & business members)

1. When voting opens on March 9, **visit our website** and navigate to the voting platform.
2. Enter the ballot number and password you received in the email or letter.
3. Read the candidate statements.
4. Follow the instructions and vote for up to three candidates.

FAQ

I'm a business member - How can I vote?

You'll need to enter the ballot number and password you received via email or letter on March 9. A duly authorized representative can vote on behalf of the business. Please note that telephone voting and logins through online banking are only available for individual members.

If I have more than one account, can I vote more than once?

Each Cambrian Credit Union member may only cast one ballot, regardless of the number of accounts they hold.

Can someone else vote on my behalf?

Cambrian Credit Union does not allow individual members to vote by proxy.

How are you protecting my privacy through online or telephone voting?

All ballots are retained and counted by a neutral, third-party agency under the supervision of a returning officer who is not an employee of Cambrian Credit Union.



Telephone

(for individual members only)

1. When voting opens on March 9, **call the number provided** in the email or letter you received. You will also be able to find the number on our website.
2. Enter the ballot number and password you received in the email or letter.
3. Follow the instructions to select, confirm, and submit your vote for up to three candidates.

When and where will the results be announced?

The election results will be shared at Cambrian's Annual General Meeting in April.
