1. Commitment to Achieving Net Zero

Njord is committed to achieving Net Zero emissions by 2045.

While the national target is 2050, we align ourselves with the NHS Net Zero Supplier Roadmap, aiming to reach Net Zero for the emissions we control (Scope 1 and 2) and those we can influence (Scope 3) five years ahead of the legal deadline.

2. Current Carbon Footprint & Scope

As a small enterprise with a turnover under £1m, our current carbon footprint is primarily driven by:

- Scope 1 & 2: Office energy consumption and business-related heating/lighting.
- Scope 3 (Subset): We monitor and are committed to reducing emissions from:
 - Business Travel: Prioritizing rail and virtual meetings over air and car travel.
 - Employee Commuting: Encouraging low-carbon transport options.
 - Waste: Implementing a rigorous "reduce and recycle" policy for all office operations.

3. Emission Reduction Projects

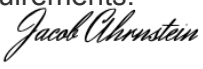
To reach our 2045 goal, Njord is committed to the following environmental management measures:

- Energy Efficiency & Tenant Advocacy: As we operate from rented office spaces, we do not have ultimate control over the primary energy contracts. However, we actively engage with our landlords to improve building performance. A current example of this is the scheduled installation of new, energy-efficient windows at our premises, which will significantly reduce heat loss and lower the carbon intensity of our heating. We continue to advocate for the transition to 100% renewable energy tariffs for all managed spaces.
- Sustainable Packaging & Circular Economy: For the transit of goods from our manufacturing base in Sweden to the UK, Njord utilizes timber crates. Unlike plastic alternatives, these are sourced from sustainably managed forests, providing natural carbon sequestration. Our packaging is biodegradable, and designed to be easily reused or recycled within the NHS waste stream.
- Logistics Optimization: We work to minimize our Scope 3 "Downstream Transportation" emissions by optimizing shipping volumes and selecting low-carbon transit routes from Sweden to the UK, reducing the total carbon intensity per unit delivered.

- Digital Transformation: We maintain a "Digital First" policy for all administrative tasks, significantly reducing paper waste and eliminating unnecessary business travel through the use of virtual collaboration tools between our UK and Sweden offices.

4. Declaration and Sign-off

This Net Zero Commitment has been reviewed and approved by the leadership of Njord Medtech Ltd. It will be updated annually to reflect our progress and any changes in NHS procurement requirements.
