- Eligibility: Most appointments require City residency or employment within the City of Oak Hill. - Sunshine Law: All meetings of City boards and committees are open to the public and must comply with Florida's Government in the Sunshine Law (Chapter 286, Florida Statutes). - Financial Disclosure: Members of certain boards may be required to file an annual Statement of Financial Interests with the State of Florida (Chapter 112, Florida Statutes). - Conflict of Interest: Appointees must avoid any appearance of conflict of interest under Florida ethics laws and City policies. - Attendance: Regular participation is essential. Failure to attend meetings may result in removal or replacement. - Equal Opportunity: The City of Oak Hill does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, age, disability, or religion.
